

NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 147

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 147 will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, October 13, 2021, at 12:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Vogler & Spencer, 777 North Eldridge Parkway, Suite 500, Houston, Texas 77079*, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

6. Adopt Resolution Nominating Candidate for Board of Directors Election for Harris County Appraisal District
7. Report on list of commercial businesses within the District.
8. Sale of Series B groundwater credits.
9. Operation of District facilities, billings, repairs and maintenance, including:
 - a. customer correspondence and message language on water bills;
 - b. facilities mowing and landscaping;
 - c. maintenance items at water plant;
 - d. sanitary sewer rehabilitation project, phase three;
 - e. discuss HCMUD120 interconnect meters; and
 - f. customer confidentiality.
10. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
11. Discuss emergency messaging and authorize action, if necessary.
12. West Harris County Regional Water Authority matters.
13. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. Chelford City Regional Wastewater Treatment Facility operations and any service area expansion requests, including requests for additional maintenance and/or repairs and Alief-Clodine shared sanitary sewer repairs;
 - b. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters, and development in and near the District;
 - c. retesting of water well;
 - d. recoating of the water plant;
 - e. GIS system; and
 - f. capital improvements plan and financing.

14. Maintenance of park and recreational facilities, including Reflection Park.

16. Reports from Directors and District consultants regarding correspondence and/or reports received during the month.
