NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a public meeting at **1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77056**, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, November 23, 2021, at 12:00 p.m.**

The Board shall consider and/or act upon the following matters:

1. Comments from the public;
2. Review and approval of the minutes of the October 26, 2021, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Authorize disbursement of bond proceeds in accordance with audit relative to the payment of proceeds of the District's \$5,285,000 Unlimited Tax Bonds, Series 2021;
4. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
5. Tax Assessor-Collector Report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds, and moving of accounts to the uncollectible roll;
6. Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney Report, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements and the filing of proofs of claim;

 20. Authorize attorney to file Eminent Domain Report with the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts prior to February 1, 2022, pursuant to Section 2206.154, Texas Government Code;

22. Discuss status of the District's compliance with America's Water Infrastructure Act of 2018, including approval of Emergency Response Plan and authorize submission of the Certificate of Completion related to same;
23. Convene in Closed Session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, for consultation with the District's attorney regarding pending or threatened litigation or matters protected by attorney-client privilege and/or Sections 551.076 and 551.089, Texas Government Code, to discuss Emergency Response Plan related to District security;
24. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any action resulting from matters discussed in Closed Session; and
25. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
