Engineering matters, including authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award contracts, approve pay estimates and change orders, authorize final acceptance of projects, and direct engineer to notify insurance company, as appropriate, for the following:
 - a. Wastewater Treatment Plant Phase 2;
 - b. Wastewater Treatment Plant left turn lane and median modifications;
 - c. Phase II MS4 Storm Water Management Plan;
 - d. update on bond application number 3; and
 - e. deeds and easements and related environmental assessment proposals, consents to encroachment and encroachment agreements, requests for service, or utility commitment letters.
12. Attorney's report, including review and update Eminent Domain Report to the Texas Comptroller; discuss eminent domain authority and *Hidalgo*
