### HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 321

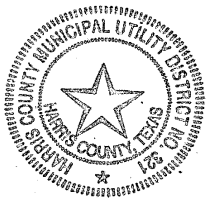
The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 321 will hold a regular meeting on Tuesday, October 19, 2021, at 11:00 a.m., at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP: 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, Trinity Room, Houston, Texas\*, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes of prior meetings.
3. Approve developer reimbursement report for Series 2021 Bonds and authorize disbursement of bond proceeds.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments, depository pledge agreements, and amendment of budget, if necessary.
5. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, payment of tax bills, and requests for estimates of taxable value.
6. Conduct public hearing regarding District's tax rate, adopt Order Levying Taxes, and authorize execution of Amendment to Information Form.
7. Operation of District facilities, including billings, repairs, maintenance, and amendment of Rate Order, if appropriate.
8. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and for damages or theft of District facilities or services and authorize termination of service.
9. City of Houston industrial user permitting matters.
10. Maintenance of detention ponds and District facility sites, including proposals for additional work.
11. Development matters.
12. Engineering matters, including authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award contracts, approve pay estimates and change orders, authorize final acceptance of projects, and direct engineer to notify insurance company, as appropriate, for the following:
  - a. detention ponds DD1 and DD2;
  - b. 12-inch water line on Ella Boulevard;
  - c. traffic signal at Greens Crossing Boulevard and Fallbrook Drive;
  - d. drainage and paving for Fallbrook Drive Street Dedication Section 2;
  - e. water well no. 3;
  - f. water well no. 3 water line extension;
  - g. next phase of District facilities;
  - h. update on Greens Crossing Drainage System ATLAS 14 Analysis;
  - i. capital improvement plan;
  - j. proposals for engineering services; and

- k. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, access agreements, pipeline crossing reimbursement and encroachment agreements, requests for service, utility commitment letters, and appraisals.
13. Interlocal Agreement with Fallbrook Utility District for second emergency water interconnect.
14. Capital budgets, letter financing agreements, collateral account agreements, site development agreements, and infrastructure work letter agreements.
15. Meeting schedule and items for inclusion on next agenda.
16. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, to conduct a private consultation with attorney.
17. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding matters considered in executive session.
