Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors ("Board") of the above captioned District will hold a public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 1400, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77056, said address being an office and meeting place of the District.

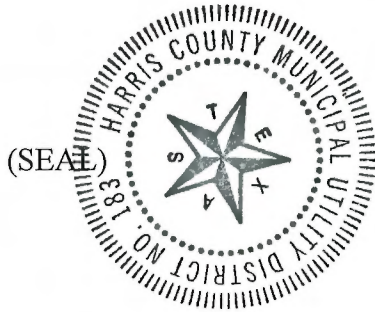
The meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 26, 2021 at 12:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Review and approve the minutes of the Board of Directors meetings held on September 28, 2021 and October 4, 2021;
3. Discussion regarding appointment of a new Director to fill the vacancy on the Board;
4. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, and authorizing payment of invoices presented and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
5. Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney, including review of Report and authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment payment agreements, the filing of proofs of claim, and termination of water service, if appropriate;
6. Review and approve audit for fiscal year ended June 30, 2020, and authorize execution of Annual Filing Affidavit;
7. Review and approve continuing disclosure report;
8. Engineer's Report, including:
 - a) Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for the construction of facilities within the District and approval of related storm water plans;
 - b) Authorizing the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities to serve land within the District, approval of any related storm water permits, and authorize acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission ("TEC") Form 1295;
 - c) Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, and approval of any change orders, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295 in connection therewith;
 - d) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes;
 - e) Bond Application Report No. 8;

- f) Proposal and Preliminary Cost Estimate for Water Plant and Remote Well Security Improvements;
 - g) Status of Emergency Response Plan pursuant to America's Water Infrastructure Act of 2018;
 - h) Traffic Signal Improvements at Barker Cypress Road and Old Greenhouse Road; and
 - i) Langham Creek Resource Sharing Group;
9. Issuance of utility commitments;
10. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports, discussion regarding status of investment of District funds, authorizing the payment of invoices presented and authorizing any other actions necessary or appropriate in connection therewith;
11. Status of compliance by the District with Texas Government Code, Chapter 2265, relative to energy reporting and authorize any action in connection therewith;
12. Operations and Maintenance Report, including:
- a) Repair and maintenance of facilities;
 - b) Written appeals of District charges;
 - c) Referral of accounts for collection and approve write-off of uncollectible accounts;
 - d) Compliance with permits and regulatory requirements, including review of any notices of violations, responses to notices and remedial action taken, self-reporting forms as and if required, and correspondence to and from regulatory agencies regarding same;
 - e) Status of Water Plant, valve and manhole repairs; and
 - f) Status of fiber-optic cable installation within the District and potential damage to District facilities;
13. Implementation of Senate Bill 3 from 87th Session and amendment to District Rate Order in connection with same;
14. Security Report, including report from Harris County Sheriff's Office;
15. Discussion regarding proposed administrative building, including (i) Contract between the District and Martinez Architects for architectural design services, and (ii) status of acquisition of tract located at the corner of Keith Harrow Boulevard and Grand Forrest Drive;
16. Convene executive session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Section 551.071 (consultation with attorney), and/or Section 551.072 (acquisition of real property or interests therein);
17. Reconvene in open session; authorize the taking of any action resulting from deliberations in executive session;

18. Attorney's Report, including Annual Maintenance for Arbitrage Analysis Report originally dated November 26, 2007, prepared by Municipal Risk Management Group, LLC; and
19. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
