NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 1400, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being an office and meeting place of the District. Said meeting will also be conducted via **telephone conference call** pursuant to Texas Government Code, Sections 551.125, as amended. **To join the meeting by telephone conference call, the phone number is 1-877-304-9269 and the access code is 698245#.** All members of the public may participate in the meeting via telephone conference call.

The meeting will be held on **Wednesday, September 22, 2021, at 11:00 A.M.**

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Review and approval of the minutes of the August 25, 2021 Board of Directors meeting;
3. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
4. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
5. Report and legal action taken by the District's Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney, authorize foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, the filing of proofs of claim and approval of turn-offs; status of water termination related thereto;
6. Conduct a public hearing regarding the adoption of the District's 2021 tax rate;
7. Levy of the District's 2021 debt service and maintenance tax rates, and the adoption of an Order in connection therewith;
8. Approval and execution of an Amendment to the Amended and Restated District Information Form;
9. Operations and Maintenance Report, including:
 - a. Appeals of District charges;
 - b. Status of delinquent accounts;
 - c. Approve write-off of uncollectible accounts;

- d. Authorize the repair and maintenance of District facilities;
 - e. Status of Storm Sewer Inlet Survey;
 - f. Status of 2021 Storm Sewer Rehabilitation Priority 1 repairs; and
 - g. Status of Sanitary Sewer Manhole repairs;
 - h. Status of purchase and installation of Fleet Zoom Remote Monitoring System for Wastewater Treatment Plant ("WWTP");
 - i. Status of replacement of Lift Pump No. 3 at WWTP; and
 - j. Implementation of H.B. 872 customer confidentiality requirements and authorize the giving of notice in connection with same;
10. Discussion regarding City of Missouri City matters, including status of sidewalk repair project; authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;
 11. Engineering Report, including:
 - a. Authorizing the design and advertisement for bids for construction of facilities on behalf of the District; report on status of design of District's Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements and Wastewater Treatment Plant Access Road;
 - b. Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates, change orders, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295 in connection therewith;
 - c. Authorizing actions necessary to comply with City of Missouri City's Storm Water Management Plan; and
 - d. Discussion regarding options for construction of a re-pressurization station to serve the District; authorize any action necessary in connection therewith ;
 12. Developer's Report, including status of development of CityPark Logistics Center;
 13. Issuance of utility commitments;
 14. Attorney's Report, including:
 - a. Status of prior Resolution Adopting Temporary Policies and Procedures in Response to Covid-19 Pandemic; and
 - b. Approval of Order Establishing Office and Meeting Places Outside the District;
 15. Closed Session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Section 551.071 to consult with the District's attorney regarding matters protected by attorney-client privilege;
