The president called the meeting to order and declared it open for such business as may come before the board.

The board approved the minutes of the meeting held on December 14, 2021.

Wendi Devita reported as to bookkeeping matters in the District.

Lina Loaiza reported as to the status of tax collections in the District. The District is 99.9% collected for 2020.

Greg Dubiel reported as to operational matters in the District. There are 274 connections in the District. The board approved an amendment to the operator contract.

Jack Miller reported as to engineering matters in the District.

The board employed Mark Eyring to audit the district records for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 and September 30, 2022.

Mark Eyring presented the audit for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021. After discussion upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously adopted, the board approved the

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audit for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021.

The board discussed the need to call an Election of Directors for and within the District on the second Saturday in May, 2022 according to law. The attached Order calling such election was presented and reviewed by the Board of Directors, after which it was duly moved, seconded, and unanimously carried that the Order be passed and adopted. The attorneys were instructed to handle the mechanics of the election.

The board unanimously approved all Consultants' reports.

There was presented to the board a list of bills for the approval of payment, a copy of which is attached hereto. After discussion, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the board approved said bills and ordered checks to be issued on the appropriate accounts of the District in payment thereof.
