Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors ("Board") of the above captioned District will hold a public meeting 1300 Post Oak Blvd., Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Thursday, January 27, 2022, at 6:30 P.M.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

JOINT SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT COMMITTEE

- A. Engineering Report:
 - i. Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295; status of contracts for the construction and/or maintenance of facilities within the District, and approving of related storm water plans, including wastewater treatment plant, lift station improvements and the rehabilitation of the joint sanitary sewer trunk lines;
 - ii. Status of preparation of the TPDES effluent permit renewal application (expires May 1, 2022);
 - iii. Status of bids for mechanical bar screen replacement; and
 - iv. Recommendations for modifications to waste order; status of discussions among participating districts regrading same;
- B. Operations Report:
 - i. Reports from all Districts regarding waste order implementation, enforcement and grit; and

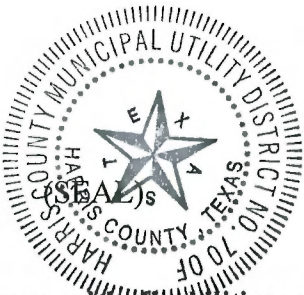
DISTRICT MEETING

1. Comments from the public;
2. Review and approve the minutes of the December 16, 2021 special Board meeting;
3. Review and approve audit for fiscal year ended September 30, 2021 (due February 12, 2022); authorize execution of Annual Filing Affidavit;

4. Review and approve Annual Financial and Operating (Continuing Disclosure) Report pursuant to SEC Rule 15c2-12 (due March 31, 2022);
5. Authorize preparation and submission of District information to Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts as required by Section 403.0241, Texas Government Code, and Chapter 203, Texas Local Government Code, for inclusion in the Special Purpose District Public Information Database;
6. Review of monthly activity report received from the Harris County Sheriff's Office; approval and/or ratification of prior approval of Interlocal Agreements for Law Enforcement Services between Harris County and the District for term beginning March 1, 2022;
7. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports, and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
8. Adoption of Resolution Adopting List of Qualified Brokers Authorized to Engage in Investment Transactions with District;
9. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including the status of delinquent tax accounts and authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds, and approve moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
10. Report and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney, and authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
11. Grant exemptions from taxation for 2022, and the adoption of a Resolution in connection therewith;

 - i. Review and approval of any Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans or Storm Water Quality Management Plans related to construction within or on behalf of District, authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, and the execution of any documentation in connection therewith;
 - (b) Authorize the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, and approval of any related storm water permits, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
 - (c) Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any change orders, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, including:
 - i. Status of rehabilitation of ground storage tank at Water Plant by A&H Coating Services, LLC;
 - (d) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes;
 - (e) Storm Water Solutions report regarding storm water quality;
 - (f) Status of wastewater sampling results for commercial customers, sampling procedures and the imposition of penalties based thereon;
 - i. Status of suspension of certain violation penalties under waste order and associated customer compliance history; and
 - ii. Recommendations for modification to waste order and/or commercial customer rates; and
 - (g) Approval of amendment to 10-year Capital Improvement Plan;
15. Discussion regarding renewal of District's insurance policies and authorize solicitation of proposals for same;
16. Issuance of utility commitments;
