


NOTICE OF MEETING

The Board of Directors of West Keegans Bayou Improvement District, Fort Bend and Harris Counties, Texas will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, April 13, 2022, at 4:45 p.m. at the Keegans Wood Clubhouse, located at 9600 Keegans Wood Drive, Houston, Texas 77083**, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Comments from the public (three minutes per person).
2. Consent agenda. (Items listed below are routine and reports have been presented with the Board materials, or the items are self-explanatory. A Board member may request that an item be taken off the consent agenda for separate consideration, all other consent agenda items will be considered under a single motion, without discussion or presentation):
 - a. Approve minutes.
 - b. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, payment of tax bills.
 - c. Financial and bookkeeping matters.
 - d. District website.
 - e. Meeting schedule (next regular meeting on May 11, 2022).
3. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. development issues;
 - b. discuss MS4 Storm Water Permit;
 - c. desilt and rehabilitation of bayou;
 - d. bayou rehabilitation;
 - e. security cameras;
 - f. graffiti abatement; and
 - g. outfall repairs.
4. Trail construction and repairs:
 - a. authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, as appropriate, in connection with the completion of the West Keegans Hike and Bike Trail Phase 1; and
 - b. recreational facilities and amenities, including District trail signage repairs.
 - c. Determine process for engagement of landscape design firm.
