NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors ("Board") of the above-captioned District will hold a public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on **Wednesday, April 27, 2022, at 11:00 A.M.**

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Review and approval of the minutes of the Board of Directors meeting held March 23, 2022;
3. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
4. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
5. Report and legal action taken by the District's Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney, authorize foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, the filing of proofs of claim and approval of turn-offs; status of water terminations related thereto;
6. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Real Property Taxes and authorize the Delinquent Tax Attorney to pursue the collection of delinquent real property taxes beginning July 1, 2022, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
7. Operations and Maintenance Report, including:
 - a. Appeals of District charges;
 - b. Status of delinquent accounts;
 - c. Approve write-off of uncollectible accounts;
 - d. Authorize the repair and maintenance of District facilities; and
 - e. Status of replacement of Blower Motor No. 2 at Wastewater Treatment Plant ("WWTP");
8. Operator's annual report regarding status of the District's Identity Theft Prevention Program ("Program"), including discussion of Program compliance, staff training, effectiveness and suggested changes;

9. Authorize Operator to draft Consumer Confidence Report for review by Board of Directors;
10. Amendment of District Rate Order, including, but not limited to addition of provisions related to collection of costs related to enforcement of violations of same;
11. Discussion regarding City of Missouri City matters, including status of sidewalk repair project; authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;
12. Engineering Report, including:
 - a. Authorizing the design and advertisement for bids for construction of facilities on behalf of the District,
 - b. Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates, change orders, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295 in connection therewith, including:
 - (i) Status of construction of WWTP Improvements (T&G Services);
 - c. Authorizing actions necessary to comply with City of Missouri City's Storm Water Management Plan;
 - d. Discussion regarding options for construction of a re-pressurization station to serve the District; authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;
 - e. Status of application for renewal of waste discharge permit for the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and
 - f. Status of communications with Colony Crossing Homeowners Association regarding the maintenance of pilot channels in detention ponds within the District;
13. Adoption of Resolution Expressing Official Intent to Reimburse Operating Account from Bond Proceeds;
14. Developer's Report, including status of development of CityPark Logistics Center, and communications with developer regarding maintenance of detention pond and proposed screening between the buildings on the City Park development and the Colony Crossing Subdivision within the District;
15. Issuance of utility commitments;
16. Attorney's Report;
17. Closed Session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Section 551.071 to consult with the District's attorney regarding matters protected by attorney-client privilege;
18. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any action resulting from matters discussed in Closed Session; and

19. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
