Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors ("Board") of the above captioned District will hold a public meeting at 1281 Brittmoore Road, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Thursday, May 26, 2022, at 6:30 P.M.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

JOINT SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT COMMITTEE

- A. Accept Qualification Statement, Bond, Oath of Office, and Affidavit of Current Director for Elected Directors;
- B. Elections Not to Disclose Certain Information;

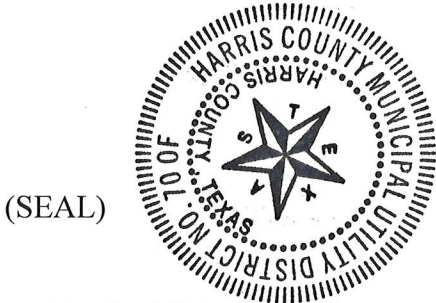



4. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports, and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
5. Approval of Unclaimed Property Report as of March 1, 2022 and authorize bookkeeper to file Report with State Comptroller prior to July 1, 2022;
6. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including the status of delinquent tax accounts and authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds, and approve moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
7. Discuss District's tax exemptions for 2022; Consider revocation of prior Resolution Concerning Tax Exemptions ("Exemption Resolution") and adoption of new Exemption Resolution;

 - (b) Authorize the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, and approval of any related storm water permits, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
 - (c) Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any change orders, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, including:
 - I. Status of Water Well Panel Replacement by RESCO Electric;
 - (d) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes;

 - (g) Conduct public hearing regarding the imposition of penalties and/or termination of service for customer violations of District Rate Order and/or Waste Order;
