10. West Harris County Regional Water Authority matters, including consider water line and meter easement.
11. Mission Bend Greenbelt Association matters.
12. Report on the Greater Mission Bend Area Council.
13. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills.
14. Discuss Community MUD Education Event and take appropriate action.
15. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, to conduct a private consultation with attorney.
16. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action.
