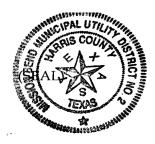
NOTICE OF MEETING

MISSION BEND MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 2

The Board of Directors of Mission Bend Municipal Utility District No. 2 will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday**, **June 21**, **2022**, **at 6:00 p.m**., at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, in the Guadalupe Room, Houston, Texas*, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

- 1. Public comments.
- 2. Approve minutes of prior meetings, including May 17 (Regular), May 31 (Integrated), June 7 (Greenbelt), and June 13 (Chelford), 2022.
- 3. Security services matters, including:
 - a. report from Harris County Sheriff's Office; and
 - b. update on the installation of signs prohibiting commercial vehicles from parking overnight.
- 4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. payment of the bills and review of investments; and
 - b. adopt amended budget for fiscal year end September 30, 2022.
- 5. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
- 6. Authorize delinquent tax attorney to proceed with collection of delinquent taxes.
- 7. Chelford City Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant matters, including updates on proposed sale of excess capacity.
- 8. Operation of District facilities, billings, repairs and maintenance, and related operating matters, including the following:
 - a. hearing on termination of water and sewer service;
 - b. update on televising of facilities in Altamira, Section 1;
 - c. update on automated meter trial program;
 - d. Mission Bend Integrated Water System operating matters; and
 - e. authorize assessment of penalties for Rate Order violations.
- 9. West Harris County Regional Water Authority matters.
- 10. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. update on stand-by generator;
 - b. update on design of permanent generators;
 - c. update on sanitary sewer cleaning and televising project;
 - d. update on implementation of Mission Bend Integrated Water System water distribution modeling and analysis software; and
 - e. update on recoating of ground storage tank no. 1 and no. 2 at water plant no. 2.
- 11. Park and recreational facility matters, including proposals, agreements, pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance, if appropriate, for the following:
 - a. Magnolia Park maintenance, including:
 - i. update on brick fence pressure washing;

- ii. update on precast fence cap washing; and
- iii. update on lighting maintenance and repair;
- b. Mission Bend Greenbelt Trail improvements project, including:
 - i. update on west side Trail expansion project; and
 - ii. update on installation of the Pedestrian Bridge dedication plaque;
- c. Little Villa Wetland improvement project, including:
 - i. update on screen planting and irrigation improvements;
 - ii. update on Memorial Plaza planting design;
 - iii. update on design and installation of western park boundary fence; and
 - iv. update on design and installation of park rules signage.
- d. Update on design of District recreational improvement projects; and
- e. Update regarding preparation of bond application no. 11, including discuss and adopt Resolutions Expressing Intent to Reimburse, if appropriate.
