The President called the meeting to order and declared it open for such business as might properly come before it.

- 1. The Board opened the meeting for public comment. Hearing none, the President continued with the agenda.
- 2. The Board considered the minutes of the meeting held July 14, 2022. Upon motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board approved the minutes as presented.
- 3. The Board recognized Ms. Michele Uong who presented the bookkeeper's report, a copy of which is attached. Mr. Bonham and Ms. Uong updated the Board on the transition to the new bookkeeping firm, Forvis, LLP. Upon motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board approved the bookkeeper's report, authorized payment of the checks listed thereon, and appointed Mr. Richard Godwin to serve as the Board's representative for any matters relating to the bookkeeping transition.
- 4. The Board recognized Brenda McLaughlin who presented the tax assessor-collector's report. The 2021 taxes are 99.1% collected. The Board reviewed and discussed the District's delinquent accounts in detail. Upon motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board approved the report as presented.
- 5. The Board noted that certified taxable values have not been received and tabled the discussion of the District's 2022 tax rate until the following month.

- 6. There was no developer's report for consideration.
- 7. Mr. Bonham then presented the mowing contract from Silver Sand Services to the Board. The Board discussed the contractual rates and the relationship between the District and the HOA established by the contract. The Board agreed to seek clarifications on the contract from Silver Sand Services and discuss the contract at the following month's meeting.
- 8. The Board recognized Garrett Robertson who presented the monthly maintenance report. Mr. Robertson then presented a proposal for the repair of a storm water quality feature that was inspected by Harris County. The Board discussed the repair in detail. Mr. Robertson presented the Board with a quote of \$3,000 to repair the storm water quality feature. The Board noted that the permit for the facility has expired and requested that Director Hughes work with Mr. Robertson to reduce the cost of the repair. Upon motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board approved the report as presented.
- 9. The Board then recognized Mr. Robert Atkinson who presented the engineer's report. Mr. Atkinson reviewed the status of ongoing projects with the Board. The Board discussed the report in detail. Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Board approved the engineers' report as presented and authorized the action items contained therein.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
