



AMENDED RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ADDRESSES AND METHODS  
FOR TEXAS PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT REQUESTS

WHEREAS, First Colony Municipal Utility District No. 10 (the "District") has been legally created and operates pursuant to the general laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, Section 552.234 of the Texas Government Code provides that a governmental entity, such as the District, may establish addresses and methods for making written requests for public information to the District pursuant to the Texas Public Information Act ("TPIA Requests"); and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the receipt and timely response to TPIA Requests, the Board of Directors of the District (the "Board") previously established addresses and methods for receiving TPIA Requests, as provided by Section 552.234 of the Texas Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined to amend the addresses and methods for TPIA Requests; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF FIRST COLONY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 10 THAT:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 552.234(c) of the Texas Government Code, the Board hereby designates the following for receipt of TPIA Requests to the District:

- a. Designated Mailing Address: First Colony Municipal Utility District No. 10

- b. Designated Electronic Mailing Address: firmud10@txdistricts.info

The District shall provide the designated mailing address and electronic mailing address for receipt of TPIA Requests to any person on request.

Section 2. The Board hereby directs the addresses and methods established herein for receipt of TPIA Requests to be printed on the sign displayed by the District pursuant to Section 552.205 of the Texas Government Code.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 552.234 of the Texas Government Code, upon printing the addresses and methods established herein for receipt of TPIA Requests on the sign required to be displayed by the governmental body under Section 552.205 of the Texas Government Code, the District shall only be required to respond to TPIA Requests received:

- a. at the designated mailing address or electronic mailing address specified in this Amended Resolution; or
- b. by hand delivery.

Section 4. The District may, at its discretion, amend or rescind this Amended Resolution at any time.

Section 5. This Amended Resolution shall be effective as of the date of adoption and shall amend and supersede the addresses and methods for TPIA Requests previously designated by Resolution dated January 12, 2022.
