NOTICE OF SPECIAL PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a special public meeting at **1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77056**, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, December 20, 2022, at 12:00 p.m.**

The Board shall consider and/or act upon the following matters:


1. Comments from the public;
2. Review and approval of the minutes of the November 22, 2022, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
4. Tax Assessor-Collector Report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds, and moving of accounts to the uncollectible roll;
5. Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney Report, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements and the filing of proofs of claim;
6. Report by Champions Hydro-Lawn, Inc. regarding maintenance of drainage facilities;
7. Status of compliance with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality Phase II Small MS4 General Permit, including public comments and any training that is necessary under the Storm Water Management Plan ("SWMP");
8. District website and mass notification messaging matters;
9. Review activity reports and/or receive updates regarding Fort Bend County Precinct 1 Constable's Office;
10. Operations and Maintenance Report, including:
 - a) Compliance with District's Water and Waste Discharge Permits;
 - b) Operation, maintenance and repair of District's water, wastewater and drainage facilities;
 - c) Appeals of District charges;
 - d) Referral of District accounts for collection and the deeming of various accounts to be uncollectible;
 - e) Maintenance of District park facilities;

- f) Report regarding water accountability;
 - g) Review results of Phase 1 of 5 (Schedule A) of District's 5-year annual sanitary sewer televising program and consider repair recommendations in connection therewith; status of related manhole inspections by Municipal Operations & Consulting, Inc;
 - h) Status of rehabilitation of the clarifier at the District's Wastewater Treatment Plant;
 - i) Status of repainting of fire hydrants within the District;
 - j) Status of replacement of the drum screen at the Joint Wastewater Treatment Plant; and
 - k) Status of implementation of Accurate Meter & Supply's Smart Meter Pilot Program;
11. Consider approval regarding District's participation in the NFBWA 2023 Water Provider Conservation Program;
 12. Memorandum on implementation of Public Utility Commission of Texas (the "PUC") rules relating to Senate Bill 3; authorize distribution of notice to District residents;
 13. Amendment of the District's Rate Order in connection with, but not limited to, implementation of PUC rules relating to Senate Bill 3;
 14. Engineer's Report, including:
 - a) Authorize the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts, and the acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission ("TEC") Form 1295 for projects, including:
 - b) Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates, change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, including:
 - i) Little Prong Creek North and South Slope Erosion Repair (AR Turnkey Construction Company, Inc.); and
 - ii) Installation of permanent emergency generator at the District's remote water well (McDonald Municipal and Industrial);
 - c) Acceptance of easements, conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
 - d) Review of updated Capital Improvement Plan;
 - e) Status of relocation of District's 12" Waterline and Waterline Easement to accommodate proposed office building footprint on 1.5 acre tract at northwest corner of FM 1093 and Gaston Road, including:
 - i) Approval of Consent to Encroachment and Indemnity Agreement by and between XAG Group and the District;
 - f) Discussion regarding North Fort Bend Water Authority effluent reuse program; and
 - g) Status of implementation of Geographic Information System by BGE, Inc.;
 15. Utility commitment requests, and acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
 16. Attorney's Report;

17. Convene in Closed Session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, for consultation with the District's attorney regarding pending or threatened litigation or matters protected by attorney-client privilege;
18. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any action resulting from matters discussed in Closed Session; and
19. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
