


## NOTICE OF MEETING

### FIRST COLONY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 10

The Board of Directors of First Colony Municipal Utility District No. 10 will hold a regular meeting on Wednesday, January 11, 2023, at 12:00 p.m., at the offices of First Colony Community Services Association, 4350 Austin Parkway, Sugar Land, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes.
3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills and review of investments.
4. Adopt amended budget for fiscal year end July 31, 2023.
5. Accept annual disclosure statements for Investment Officer and bookkeeper.
6. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
7. Adopt Resolution Concerning Exemptions from Taxation.
8. Approve Annual Report and authorize filing of same in accordance with the District's Continuing Disclosure of Information Agreement and as required by SEC Rule 15c2-12.
9. Annual review of Procedures for Continuing Disclosure Compliance.
10. Annual report regarding Post-Issuance Compliance Policy.
11. Maintenance and repair of District facilities (FCCA) and community development projects, including:
  - a. amendment to maintenance agreement for recreational facilities; and
  - b. bulkhead repairs and tree removal and trimming.
12. Discuss Brooks Lake Trail and review plans for improvement, including:
  - a. modification of trail lights; and
  - b. camera installation matters.
13. Long term park planning and project development, including discuss development of parks and recreational facilities in the District, park funding options, and City of Sugar Land park funding program.
14. Meeting schedule.
15. Conduct workshop regarding District projects.
