- 10. Operation of District facilities, including billings, repairs, maintenance, and amendment of Rate Order, if appropriate.
- 11. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and for damages or theft of District facilities or services and authorize termination of service.
- 12. City of Houston industrial user permitting matters.
- 13. Maintenance of detention ponds and District facility sites, including proposals for additional work.
