HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 439

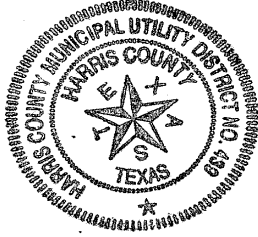


1. Comments from the public.

 - b. review bids and award contracts;
 - i. Wayside Village 12 inch watermain extension project;
 - c. approve pay estimate, change order, and final acceptance for the following:
 - i. Wayside Village Sec. 9 WSD and Parker Road Phase II WSD (Starlight Homes);
 - ii. Wayside Village Sec. 12 WSD (Rausch Coleman Homes);
 - iii. Wayside Village Phase I Detention Facilities and Wayside Village Phase I HCFCD Improvements;
