The president called the meeting to order and declared it open for such business as may come before the board.

The board approved the minutes of the board meeting held on February 14, 2023.

Dana Davis reported as to bookkeeping matters in the District.

Lina Loaiza reported as to the status of tax collections in the District. The District is 95.3% collected for 2022.

Mike Plunkett reported as to operational matters in the District. There are 391 connections in the District.

Chad Walker reported as to engineering matters in the District. The board awarded the

contract for the Lift Station No. 2 Generator Addition project to CSE W-Industries, Inc. in the amount of \$125,169.00. The board authorized the engineer to proceed with the design of the Public 8-inch Sanitary Sewer Extension to serve 3203 FM1960.

Troy Tezeno discussed the general manager report.

The board unanimously approved insurance renewal proposals for property, general liability, boiler and machinery, directors' and officers' liability, and consultants' bonds.

The board unanimously approved all Consultants' reports.
