1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes of prior meetings, including September 19 (Regular), October 3 (Greenbelt), and October 9 (Chelford), 2023.
3. Security services matters, including:
 - a. report from Harris County Sheriff's Office; and
 - b. update on the implementation of signs prohibiting commercial vehicles from parking overnight.

5. Review proposal for 2023 holiday light decorations and authorize, if appropriate.
