 - (d) correspondence from customers of the District, including requests for adjustments;
- 3. Report on Storm Water Detention Facilities (as needed);
- 4. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including:
 - (a) approval of payments from the District's tax account;
 - (b) status of collection of taxes, penalties, and interest due to the District for real and personal property accounts and consider termination of services for such accounts;
 - (c) status of collection activities by delinquent tax attorney;
- Engineer's Report (updates as needed);
- 6. Old business, including:
 - (a) review of the security report from the Harris County Sheriff's Office;
 - (b) status of Bond Application Report;
- 7. New Business;
- 8. Attorney's Report, including discuss and possibly adopt Resolution concerning use of surplus construction funds;
- Convene in executive session pursuant to Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, to discuss matters only relating to pending or contemplated litigation, personnel matters, real estate transactions, or security, if necessary;

- 10. Action related to matters discussed during executive session; and
- 11. Schedule future meetings as required (next meeting date 24 January 2024).

Notice: After at least 50 qualified electors are residing in a district, on written request of at least five of those electors, the board shall designate a meeting place and hold meetings within the district if it determines that the meeting place used by the district deprives the residents of a reasonable opportunity to attend district meetings. On the failure to designate the location of the meeting place within the district, five electors may petition the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to designate a location. If it determines that the meeting place used by the district deprives the residents of a reasonable opportunity to attend district meetings, the TCEQ may designate a meeting place inside or outside the district which is reasonably available to the public and require that the meetings be held at such place. After the next election, the board may designate different meeting places, including one located outside the boundaries of the district.
