The meeting will be held on Thursday, April 25, 2024, at 6:30 P.M.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

JOINT SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT COMMITTEE

- A. Consider comments to the Joint Sewage Treatment Plant Committee portion of the March 28, 2024, Board meeting minutes;
- B. Engineering Report:
 - i. Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295; status of contracts for the construction and/or maintenance of facilities within the District, and approving of related storm water plans, including wastewater treatment plant, lift station improvements and the rehabilitation of the joint sanitary sewer trunk lines; and

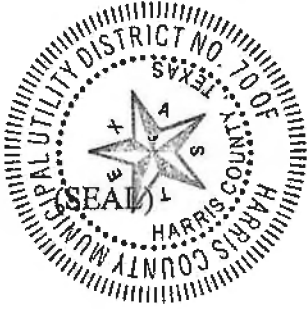

3. Review of monthly activity report received from the Harris County Sheriff's Office and correspondence regarding Fiscal Year 2025 Rate Increase;
4. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports, and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
5. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including the status of delinquent tax accounts and authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds, and approve moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
6. Report and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney, and authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
7. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Real Property Taxes and authorize the delinquent tax attorney to pursue the collection of delinquent real property taxes beginning July 1, 2024, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
