


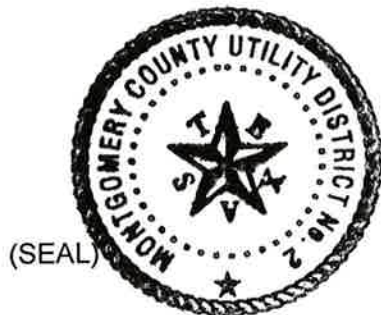

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Montgomery County Utility District No. 2 will hold a regular meeting, open to the public, on **FRIDAY, 24 MAY 2024, at 9:00 A.M.**, at Municipal Accounts & Consulting, LP, **611 Longmire Road, Suite 1, Conroe, Texas 77304**, outside the boundaries of the District. **Guests attending the meeting via ZOOM videoconference, please join the meeting at <https://us06web.zoom.us/j/3671196583> or dial 1-346-248-7799 and enter Meeting ID: 367 119 6583.** The Board will consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Consider comments from District residents (five-minute limit for each speaker);
2. Approve the minutes of the meeting of 26 April 2024;
3. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including:
 - (a) approval of payments from the District's Tax Account;
 - (b) discuss the list of top delinquent taxpayers;
 - (c) possible action on uncollectible accounts;
4. Delinquent Tax Attorney's Report;
5. Bookkeeper's Report, including:
 - (a) authorize payment of the District's bills and wire transfers;
 - (b) review investments;
 - (c) discuss reserve in District's Operating Fund;
 - (d) authorization to escheat unclaimed funds to the Texas Comptroller;
 - (e) amend budget for the fiscal year ending 30 April 2025, if necessary;

 - (a) status of District's Strategic Plan;
 - (b) status of storm sewer outfall inspections and repairs;

 - (e) status of sanitary sewer line rehabilitation and replacements;
 - (f) discuss emergency water interconnection (Far Hills Utility District);
 - (g) status of repairs to ground storage tanks;
 - (h) status of Phase II MS4 General Permit;
 - (i) discuss and authorize any repairs or other work as necessary;

 - (a) status of operation of the District's water and wastewater facilities;
 - (b) discuss monthly and annual averages for unaccounted water;
 - (c) discuss and authorize any repairs or other work as necessary;

 - (f) consider termination of service to delinquent accounts;
 - (g) review actions related to revised Lead and Copper Rule (EPA);
