NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a regular meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Friday, June 21, 2024, at 12:00 Noon.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public Comments;
2. Approval of minutes of the May 24, 2024, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Tax Assessor-Collector Report, including reviewing the status of delinquent tax accounts, authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds, and approving moving of accounts to the uncollectible roll;
4. Report and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
5. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
6. Engineer's Report, including:
 - (i) Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for the construction of facilities within the District, authorizing acceptance of TEC Form 1295, and approving of related storm water plans, including:
 - (a) Review and approval of any Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans or Storm Water Quality Management Plans related to construction within or on behalf of the District, and the execution of any documentation in connection therewith;
 - (ii) Award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for construction of facilities within the District, and acceptance of TEC Form 1295, and approval of any related storm water permits;
 - (iii) Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any change orders, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, as applicable;
 - (a) New Wastewater Treatment Plant (R&B Group, Inc.) (District Project);
 - (iv) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes;
 - (v) Status of street and storm sewer acceptance by Harris County;

- (vi) Discussion regarding proposed installation of permanent fence at Wastewater Treatment Plant site;
 - (vii) Status of replacement of water well pump located at Joint Water Plant No. 1 by Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 276;
 - (viii) Status of replacement of pavement in Kingfield, Section 2 by Beyer Construction, LLC; and
 - (ix) Discussion regarding proposed installation of generator at Joint Water Plant No. 2;

 11. Report by Republic Services, Inc. concerning solid waste collection and recycling activities within the District; consider proposal for automated side load service;
