Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors ("Board") of the above captioned District will hold a regular public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District.

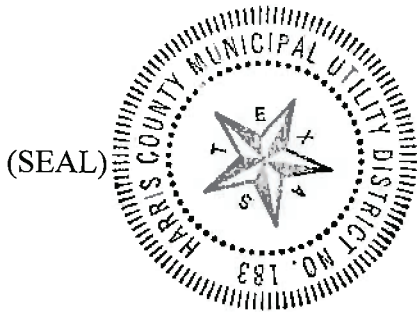
The meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 22, 2024 at 12:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Review and approve the minutes of the Board of Directors meeting held on September 24, 2024;
3. Conduct a public hearing regarding the adoption of the District's 2024 tax rate;
4. Levy of the District's 2024 debt service and maintenance tax rates, and the adoption of an Order in connection therewith;
5. Approval and execution of an Amendment to the District's Fourth Amended and Restated District Information Form;
6. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports, discussion regarding status of investment of District funds, authorizing the payment of invoices presented, and authorizing any other actions necessary or appropriate in connection therewith;
7. Annual Review of Amended Order Establishing Policy for Investment of District Funds and Appointing Investment Officer, and adoption of Resolution in connection therewith;
8. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, and authorizing payment of invoices presented and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
9. Review and approve audit for fiscal year ended June 30, 2024, and authorize execution of Annual Filing Affidavit;
10. Continuing disclosure report;

11. Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney Report, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment payment agreements, the filing of proofs of claim, and termination of water service, if appropriate;
12. Operations and Maintenance Report, including:
 - a) Repair and maintenance of facilities, including the repairs identified in Quiddity Engineering's Annual Water Plant Inspection;
 - b) Written appeals of District charges;
 - c) Referral of accounts for collection and approve write-off of uncollectible accounts;
 - d) Compliance with permits and regulatory requirements, including review of any notices of violations, responses to notices and remedial action taken, self-reporting forms as and if required, and correspondence to and from regulatory agencies regarding same; and
 - e) Discussion regarding water meter replacement program and related costs;
13. Engineer's Report, including:
 - a) Authorizing design for the construction of facilities within the District and approval of related storm water plans, including:
 - (i) Sanitary Sewer Extension for the Exploring Minds Learning Center;
 - b) Authorizing the advertisement for bids for the construction of facilities within the District, including:
 - (i) Windsong Phase I Waterline Replacement – Phase I;
 - c) Authorizing the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities to serve land within the District, approval of any related storm water permits, and authorize acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission ("TEC") Form 1295 in connection therewith;
 - d) Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, and approval of any change orders, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295 in connection therewith, including:
 - (i) 2023 Water Plant No. 1 Improvements – W.W. Payton Corporation;
 - (ii) Generator Addition at Remote Water Well No. 2 – McDonald Municipal and Industrial; and
 - (iii) Grand Forest Drive Waterline Loop Project – Faith Utilities, LLC;
 - e) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes;
 - f) Jackrabbit Road Public Utility District ("JRRPUD") Clarifier No. 2 Rehabilitation;
 - g) Water Plant and Remote Well Security Improvements;
 - h) Emergency Preparedness Plan and Emergency Communication Plan;
 - i) Emergency Communication Subcommittee;
 - j) Additional Water Well Performance Testing; and
 - k) Customer violation of plan approval;

14. Issuance of utility commitments, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, in connection therewith;
15. Discussion regarding proposed administrative building, including approval of an agreement for architectural services with LDDBlueline, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, in connection therewith ;
16. Security Report, including: (i) report from Harris County Sheriff's Office; (ii) discussion regarding revisions to Independent Contractor Agreements (Patrol Services); (iii) installation of signs at the District's facilities with non-emergency number; (iv) discussion regarding the District operator's responsibilities regarding surveillance equipment; (v) discussion regarding monitoring services response procedures; and (vi) discussion regarding vendors' data protection measures and restoration and emergency protocols;
17. Convene executive session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Section 551.071 (consultation with attorney), and/or Section 551.072 (acquisition of real property or interests therein);
18. Reconvene in open session; authorize the taking of any action resulting from deliberations in executive session;
19. Attorney's Report; and
20. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
