CONSENT AGENDA: The following items are considered routine by the Board and will be enacted by one motion. No separate discussion will occur on these items unless a Board member so requests, in which event, the item will be removed and placed on the Regular Agenda.


1. Approve minutes.
2. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments.
3. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
4. Operator's report of District water, sanitary sewer, and stormwater facilities, including billings, repairs and maintenance.

6. Water conservation and drainage matters, including update on federal grant application for District drainage projects, associated cost, timeline for implementation, and related matters.
7. Additional bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. approve Director per diems;
 - b. conduct annual review of Investment Policy and adopt Resolution Regarding Annual Review of Investment Policy;
 - c. review, revise, and adopt Resolution Establishing the Authorized Depository Institutions and Adopting List of Qualified Broker/Dealers with Whom the District May Engage in Investment Transactions; and
 - d. amend budget for fiscal year end August 31, 2025.
8. Additional operating matters, including:
 - a. authorize operator to send uncollectable accounts to collection agency;
 - b. customer contact log; and
 - c. Drought Contingency Plan matters.
9. Hearing on termination of water service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
10. Additional tax assessment and collection matters, including review delinquent tax roll and write off accounts, as appropriate.

11. Update on Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 364 trail modifications project.
12. Recreational and landscape matters, including:
 - a. approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance, as appropriate;
 - b. trail, detention and common area maintenance, signage, water fountains, and interactive fountain;
 - c. fencing repairs and replacement; and
 - d. tree installation, maintenance, and removal.
13. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. utility availability requests;
 - b. design, plan approval, advertisement for bids, contract award, approval of pay estimates and change orders, materials and field testing, permitting, storm water quality management plans, storm water pollution prevention plans, and other necessary actions relating to facilities, including:
 - i. joint channel and drainage repairs;
 - ii. smart meters; and
 - iii. erosion repair of backslope interceptor.
 - c. feasibility study regarding potential water plant control system improvements;
 - d. deeds, easements, and encroachments;
 - e. annual review of capital improvement plan;
 - f. update on conveyance of lift station no. 2 site to the District and take appropriate action; and
 - g. other engineering matters.

15. Maintenance and repairs to District and joint drainage and detention facilities, including:
 - a. review inspection report and approve related proposals for work; and
 - b. update on Joint Drainage Committee matters.

17. Communication matters, including report from Communications Committee, updates to District website, and take appropriate action.
