NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a regular public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Monday, November 18, 2024, at 1:30 p.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action necessary or appropriate with respect to such matters:

- 1. Public Comments;
- 2. Review and approve the minutes of the October 21, 2024, Board meeting;
- 3. Receive and act upon bids for the purchase of the District's \$11,250,000 Unlimited Tax Bonds, Series 2024 ("Bonds"), and take the following actions related to the Bonds:
 - a) Adoption of an Order authorizing the issuance, sale and delivery of the Bonds;
 - b) Approval and distribution of Final Official Statement;
 - c) Approval and execution of Paying Agent/Registrar Agreement by and between the District and The Bank of New York Mellon Trust Company; and
 - d) Any other matters concerning the Bonds, including the approval and execution of various documents for inclusion in the transcript of proceedings to be submitted to the Attorney General of the State of Texas;
- 4. Tax Assessor-Collector report, including authorizing payment of invoices presented and approve moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
- 5. Review and approval of Amended and Restated Agreement for Services of Tax Assessor and Collector between the District and BLICO, INC., dba Bob Leared Interests; authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;
- 6. Report and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney, including:
 - a) Appeals of termination of water service for delinquent tax accounts; and the taking of any action in connection therewith, including authorizing water termination, foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
