
FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 206

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 206 will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday, January 14, 2025, at 12:30 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2600, Neches Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, approve and act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes of prior meeting(s).
3. Electricity Contract Renewal.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. payment of the bills, review of budget, and review of investments; and
 - b. accept annual disclosure statements for Investment Officer and bookkeeper
5. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, payment of tax bills, and estimate of value, as appropriate.
6. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - a. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service; and
 - b. amend Rate Order.
7. Storm water facilities maintenance and operations, including:
 - a. Focal Point Basin Maintenance;
 - b. Detention Pond/Drainage Swale Maintenance; and
 - c. proposals for additional maintenance work.
8. Engineering matters, including authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award contracts, approve pay estimates and change orders, authorize final acceptance of projects, and direct engineer to notify insurance company, as appropriate, for the following:
 - a. Phase II MS4 Storm Water Management Plan;
 - b. Interconnect Agreement with Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 30;
 - c. deeds and easements and related environmental assessment proposals, consents to encroachment and encroachment agreements, requests for service, or utility commitment letters;
 - d. water plant maintenance, including water plant no. 1 tank repair; and
 - e. Resolution Authorizing Use of Surplus Funds.
9. Attorney's report, including:
 - a. annual report regarding Post-Issuance Compliance Policy;

- b. approve Annual Report and authorize filing of same in accordance with the District's Continuing Disclosure of Information Agreement and as required by SEC Rule 15c2-12;
 - c. annual Review of Procedures for Continuing Disclosure Compliance; and
 - d. adopt Resolution Adopting Covered Applications Policy.
