


## NOTICE OF MEETING

### HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 365

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 365 will hold a special meeting on **Thursday, January 30, 2025**, at **6:00 p.m.**, at the Coles Crossing Community Center, 13050 Barker Cypress Road, Cypress, Texas 77429\*, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comment.\*\*
2. Joint facilities matters with Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 364 (“MUD 364”) and homeowners associations (“HOAs”), including:
  - a. electronic smart meters;
  - b. maintenance of shared outfall pipes; and
  - c. maintenance of detention and common areas.
3. Parks and recreational amenities matters, including:
  - a. update on MUD 364 trail improvements project; and
  - b. tree grant/donation programs.
4. Review Drought Contingency Plan and discuss potential amendments to same.
5. Coles Crossing Stormwater Detention and Water Quality Improvement Project, including:
  - a. associated costs, federal grant, timeline for implementation, consider proposal for engineering services, and related matters.
6. Community events.

Comments should be directed to the entire board, not individual members. Engaging in verbal attacks or comments intended to insult, abuse, malign, or slander any individual shall be cause for termination of time privileges.**
