
The meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 28, 2025 at 12:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

- 1. Public comments;
- 2. Review and approve the minutes of the Board of Directors meeting held on December 30, 2024;
- 3. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports, discussion regarding status of investment of District funds, authorizing the payment of invoices presented, and authorizing any other actions necessary or appropriate in connection therewith;
- 4. Authorize preparation and submission of District information to Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts as required by Section 403.0241, Texas Government Code, and Chapter 203, Texas Local Government Code, for inclusion in the Special Purpose District Public Information Database;
- 5. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, and authorizing payment of invoices presented and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
- 6. Grant exemptions from taxation for 2025, and the adoption of a Resolution in connection therewith;
- 7. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Personal Property Taxes and authorize delinquent tax attorney to collect delinquent personal property taxes beginning April 1, 2025, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
- 8. Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney Report, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment payment agreements, the filing of proofs of claim, and termination of water service, if appropriate;

 - (i) Windsong Phase I Waterline Replacement Phase I;
 - c) Authorizing the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities to serve land within the District, approval of any related storm water permits, and authorize acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission ("TEC") Form 1295 in connection therewith;
 - d) Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, and approval of any change orders, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295 in connection therewith, including:
 - (i) 2023 Water Plant No. 1 Improvements W.W. Payton Corporation; and
