NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a regular meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77056, said address being outside the District. The meeting will be held on **Wednesday, January 15, 2025, at 12:00 Noon**. The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:
