NOTICE OF SPECIAL PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a special public meeting at **The Rosenberg Civic Center located at 3825 Highway 36 South, Rosenberg, Texas 77471**, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Wednesday, November 6, 2024, at 3:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Comments from the public;
2. Review and approval of the minutes of the September 19, 2024, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Bookkeeper's Report, financial and investment reports, including (i) authorizing the payment of invoices presented, and (ii) adoption of an operating budget for the District's fiscal year ending December 31, 2025;
4. Annual review of Order Establishing Policy for Investment of District Funds and Appointing Investment Officer, and adoption of Resolution in connection therewith;
5. Tax Assessor-Collector Report, status of delinquent tax collections, authorize moving of accounts to uncollectible roll and authorize payment of invoices presented;
6. Conduct a public hearing regarding the adoption of the District's 2024 tax rate;
7. Levy of the District's 2024 debt service and maintenance tax rates, and the adoption of an Order in connection therewith;
8. Approval and execution of an Amendment to the District Information Form;
9. Report and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorneys, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements and the filing of proofs of claim;
10. Engagement of auditor to prepare the District's audit report for its fiscal year ending December 31, 2024;
11. Authorize attorney to file Eminent Domain Report with the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts prior to February 1, 2025, pursuant to §2206.154, Texas Government Code;
12. Engineer's Report, including approval of utility commitment(s);

13. Discussion regarding renewal of District insurance coverages and authorize solicitation of proposals for same;
14. Attorney's Report; and
15. Matters for possible placement on future agenda and establish next meeting date.
