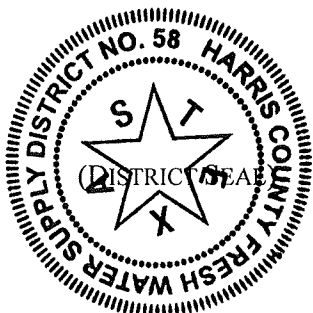


## HARRIS COUNTY FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 58


Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 551.001 et seq, of the Texas Government Code, that the Board of Directors of Harris County Fresh Water Supply District No. 58 will meet in **regular** session, open to the public, at **7:00 p.m.**, on **Thursday, May 8, 2025** at the **Indian Shores Community Center, 20731 Appaloosa Trail, Crosby, Harris County, Texas**, at which meeting the following items will be considered:

1. Receive questions/problems/suggestions from Harris County Fresh Water Supply District No. 58 customers/taxpayers (Please limit presentation to 5 minutes; if more time is required, please present the Board with 5 copies of a written presentation);
2. Consider approval of minutes of meeting of April 10, 2025;
3. Hear reports regarding the management of the community center, swimming pool administration, golf course, mowing and security and take any necessary action;
4. Discuss the use of community pool for swimming lessons and take any necessary action;
5. Hear operator's report, discuss district operations and any appeals, receive input from operator concerning same and take any necessary action; Discuss Daily Monitoring Report requirements and take any necessary action;
6. Consider approval of Consumer Confidence Report and take any necessary action;
7. Hear engineer's report, consider approval of any change orders, authorize any advertisements for bids or the award of any contracts; consider any capacity requests and take any necessary action;
8. Hear tax assessor-collector's report and take any necessary action;
9. Hear treasurer's report and take any necessary action;
10. Review budget for fiscal year ending June 30, 2026 and take any necessary action;
11. Consider engagement of auditor for fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 and take any necessary action;
12. Review any new business before the Board; and
13. Adjournment.
