NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a regular public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on **Monday, June 16, 2025, at 1:30 p.m.**


The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action necessary or appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public Comments;
2. Review and approve the minutes of the May 19, 2025, Board meeting;
3. Trash and recycling collection report from GFL Environmental;
4. Tax Assessor-Collector report, including authorizing payment of invoices presented and approve moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
5. Status of audit and status of continuing disclosure report due August 13, 2025;
6. Report and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney, including:
 - a) Appeals of termination of water service for delinquent tax accounts; and the taking of any action in connection therewith, including authorizing water termination, foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
7. Bookkeeper's Report, including payment of invoices presented;
8. Operations and Maintenance report, including:
 - a) Authorize repairs and maintenance of District facilities, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, as applicable, including:
 - b) Appeals of District charges;
 - c) Referral of accounts for collection and approve write-off of uncollectible accounts;
 - d) Communications with customers, including mass messaging; and
 - e) Submission of updated contact information and/or descriptive information regarding District facilities that qualify for critical load status to the County Office of Emergency Management, Public Utility Commission, and the Division of Emergency Management of the Governor, relative to compliance with Section 13.1396, Texas Water Code;
9. Engineering report, including:
 - a) Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for the construction of facilities within the District, including:

1. Status of design of Water Plant Replacement Project;
- b) Authorize the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, as applicable, and approval of any related stormwater permits;
- c) Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any change orders, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, as applicable, including:
 1. Rehabilitation of digesters at Wastewater Treatment Plant;
- d) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, as applicable;
- e) Capital Improvement Plan; and
- f) Status of inspection of Lift Station No. 1 by Quiddity Engineering LLC;
10. Report from Champions Hydro-Lawn, Inc., including maintenance of detention facilities for the 4.66 acres Barker Cypress/FM 529, L.P. tract, the sites of the Wastewater Treatment Plant, Water Plant, and Off-Site Lift Station, and the Harris County Flood Control District channel;
11. Discussion regarding surface water issues relative to the West Harris County Regional Water Authority;
12. Authorize completion, execution and filing with the Secretary of State of Voting System Annual Filing Form relative to District elections;
13. Request from Records Management Officer to destroy certain records of the District;
14. Attorney's Report, including:
 - a) Status of litigation by Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 257 against Si Environmental, LLC and the District regarding reported usage amounts related to expenses to operate and maintain joint Water Plant and joint Wastewater Treatment Plant (Cause No. 2022-79830; 61st District Court, Harris County, Texas);
15. Closed Session pursuant to Texas Open Meetings Act, including but not limited to consultation with attorney pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code regarding pending or threatened litigation and/or matters protected by attorney-client privilege;
16. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any action resulting from matters discussed in Closed Session; and
17. Consideration of matters for possible placement on future agendas.
