


NOTICE OF MEETING

10. Engineering matters, including authorize design of facilities, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award contracts, approve pay estimates and change orders, and authorize final acceptance of projects, if appropriate, for the following:
 - a. water, sewer, drainage, and paving facilities to serve Sunterra;
 - b. deeds, easements, encroachment agreements, waivers of special appraisal, and plat matters; and
 - c. other engineering matters.
