

NOTICE OF MEETING

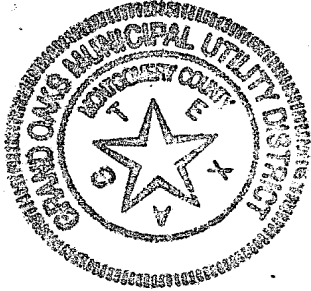
GRAND OAKS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY, TEXAS

The Board of Directors of Grand Oaks Municipal Utility District of Montgomery County, Texas will hold a regular meeting on Tuesday, August 26, 2025, at 12:00 p.m., at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, Blanco Conference Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Receive public comments.
2. Approve minutes of prior meetings.
3. Garbage service matters.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. payment of bills and review of investments; and
 - b. budget for fiscal year end September 30, 2026.
5. Amend Joint Maintenance Agreement with Grand Oaks Homeowners Association.
6. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, payment of tax bills, and requests for estimates of taxable value.
7. Discuss 2025 tax rate, set public hearing date, and authorize notice of public hearing regarding adoption of tax rate.
8. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - a. billings, repairs, and maintenance; and
 - b. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
9. Drainage and detention facility maintenance matters, including repairs to District drainage facilities and proposals for work.
10. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. approve pay estimates and change orders, including:
 - i. Glen Oaks, Section 6, clearing and grubbing; and
 - ii. Glen Oaks, Section 6, water, sanitary sewer, and drainage;
 - b. deeds, easements, execution of plats, consents to encroachment, conveyances, and requests for service or utility commitment letters; and
 - c. update on preparation of bond application no. 5 and adopt Resolution Authorizing Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for Approval of Project and Bonds.
11. Adopt Resolution Establishing Addresses and Methods for Texas Public Information Act Requests.

12. Convene in Executive Session to consult with attorney pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code.
