The President called the meeting to order and declared it open for such business as might properly come before it.

- 1. The Board considered the minutes of the meetings held on each of August 19, 2025 and September 2, 2025 and upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the Board approved the minutes as presented.
- 2. The Board then recognized Bob Ideus who presented the bookkeeper's report. The Board reviewed the report and checks presented for signature in detail. After discussion, upon unanimous vote, the Board approved the bookkeeper's report and the checks listed thereon.
- 3. The Board then reviewed a proposal from Forvis, LLP who presented a proposal for performing the District's audit for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025. After discussion, upon unanimous vote, the Board approved the proposal.
- 4. The Board then recognized Ms. Michelle Guerrero who presented the tax assessor/collector's report reflecting the District's 2024 taxes to be 98.7% collected. After discussion, upon unanimous vote, the Board approved the tax assessor/collector's report as presented.
- 5. The Board then considered the District's tax rate. The Board considered the attached Resolution Finding District to be Low Tax Rate, Developed, Developing, or Developed District in a Declared Disaster Area, Calling Public Hearing on 2025 Tax Rate, and

Authorizing Tax Assessor-Collector to Prepare and Publish Notice of the Public Hearing. After discussion, upon unanimous vote, the Board adopted the attached Resolution and authorized publication of a Notice of a Public Hearing at which the Board will consider adoption of a total 2025 tax rate of \$0.315 per \$100 assessed valuation, which the Board noted consists of a debt service tax rate of \$0.04 and a maintenance tax rate of \$0.275.

- 6. The Board then considered the engineer's report. The Board reviewed the report in detail. After discussion, upon unanimous vote, the Board approved the engineer's report.
- 7. The Board then considered the monthly drainage facility maintenance report. The Board reviewed the report in detail. Upon motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board approved the report as presented.
- 8. The Board then considered the Agreed Order. The Board then reviewed the conditions therein and discussed the status of plan operations and permit compliance with the operator. Upon motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board approved the Order as presented.
