Minutes of Meeting of Board of Directors

September 8, 2025

The Board of Directors ("Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 216 ("District") met at 2727 Allen Parkway, Suite 1100, Houston, Harris County, Texas, on September 8, 2025, in accordance with the duly posted notice of the meeting, with a quorum of directors present as follows:

Also present were Mr. Bob Ideus of Municipal Business Services, Inc.; Ms. Michelle Guerrero of Bob Leared Interests; Mr. Mark Ivy of Marlon Ivy & Associates; Mr. Ronnie Koehn of Koehn & Associates Engineers, Inc.; Mr. Trevor Konopka of The GMS Group, L.L.C.; and Mr. James D. Bonham, attorney for the District.

The meeting was called to order and declared open for such business as might properly come before it.

1. The Board considered the minutes of the Board of Directors meeting held August 11, 2025, and upon motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board approved the minutes as presented.

2. The Board then recognized Mr. Bob Ideus who presented the bookkeeper's report. The Board reviewed invoices presented by the bookkeeper and reviewed a schedule of District investments. The Board also reviewed the general fund budget comparison of actual budgeted revenues and expenditures for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026. After review and discussion, upon unanimous vote, the Board approved the bookkeeper's report and the checks listed thereon.

3. The Board then reviewed the tax assessor/collector's report reflecting the District's 2024 taxes to be 98.3% collected. The Board reviewed a schedule of delinquent taxes, and after discussion, upon motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board approved the tax assessor/collector's report and the checks drawn on the tax account.

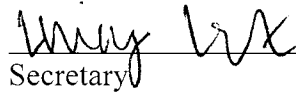
4. The Board then recognized Mr. Trevor Konopka, the District's financial advisor, who presented a cash flow analysis and recommendation with respect to the District's 2025 tax rate. The Board reviewed the analysis and recommendation, as well as the 2025 voter-

approval tax rate worksheet. The Board considered the attached Resolution Finding District to be Low Tax Rate, Developed, Developing, or Developed District in a Declared Disaster Area, Calling Public Hearing on 2025 Tax Rate, and Authorizing Tax Assessor-Collector to Prepare and Publish Notice of the Public Hearing. After discussion, upon unanimous vote, the Board adopted the attached Resolution and authorized publication of a Notice of a Public Hearing at which the Board will consider adoption of a total 2025 tax rate of \$0.445 per \$100 assessed valuation, which consists of a debt service tax of \$0.22 and a maintenance tax of \$0.225.

5. Mr. Mark Ivy then presented the operator's report reflecting 75 total accounts in the District. The Board reviewed the operation of the water plant and the wastewater treatment plant. Mr. Ivy reported that 90.4% of the water pumped during the previous month had been accounted for and reported no waste discharge permit violations. Mr. Ivy also reviewed with the Board the repairs and maintenance to the District's facilities during the month. After discussion by the Board, upon unanimous vote, the Board approved the operator's report and authorized termination of water service to all customers on the delinquent account list in accordance with the District's Rate Order.

6. Mr. Ronnie Koehn then presented the engineer's report. After review and discussion, upon unanimous vote, the Board approved the engineer's report.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.

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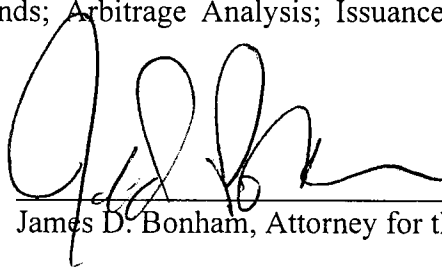
