The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

- 1. Public comments;
- 2. Review and approve the minutes of the September 17, 2025, Board of Directors meeting;
- 3. Bookkeeper's Report, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
- 4. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including status of tax valuations by Montgomery Central Appraisal District;
- 5. Authorize preparation and filing of initial Local Government Bond, Tax, and Project report pursuant to chapter 403, Texas Gov't Code, as amended by H.B. 103;
- 6. Financial Advisor's Report, including recommendation concerning the District's proposed 2025 tax rate, determine intended tax rate, and authorize:

  - d. Authorize execution of an Amendment to the District's District Information Form regarding the Road Bonds;
  - e. Adoption of Resolution Adopting Procedures for Post-Issuance Compliance; and
  - f. Act upon any other matters in connection with the issuance of the Road Bonds, including the approval and execution of various closing documents and authorization for Bond Counsel to approve closing on the sale of the Road Bonds;
- 8. Requests for annexation and exclusion of land including:
  - a. Status of city consent to annexation of 29.236 acres of land and 32.36 acres of land, respectively; and

- b. Consider the calling of a hearing on the exclusion of lands from the boundaries of the District, adoption of an Order regarding same, and authorize publication of notice of such hearing;
