

## HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 569

### NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a regular meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on **Monday, August 12, 2024, at 1:00 p.m.**

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public Comments;
2. Review and approve minutes of the July 22, 2024, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Receive and act upon bids for the purchase of the District's \$3,375,000 Unlimited Tax Bonds, Series 2024 (the "Bonds"), and consider taking the following actions in connection with the Bonds:
  - a. Adoption of an Order authorizing the issuance, sale and delivery of the Bonds;
  - b. Approval and distribution of Final Official Statement;
  - c. Approval and execution of Paying Agent/Registrar Agreement by and between the District and The Bank of New York Mellon Trust Company, N.A.;
  - d. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing Issuance of Notice of Redemption of the District's \$1,565,000 Bond Anticipation Note, Series 2023;
  - e. Any other matters concerning the Bonds, including the approval and execution of various documents for inclusion in the transcript of proceedings to be submitted to the Attorney General of the State of Texas; and
  - f. Engagement of auditor for preparation of audit of payments to the developer out of the proceeds of the Bonds;
4. Status of proposed issuance of the District's \$8,855,000 Unlimited Tax Road Bonds, Series 2024 (the "Road Bonds") and consider taking the following actions in connection with the Road Bonds, including:
  - a. Approval of Summary of Costs and pre-audit relative to payment of proceeds of the Road Bonds;
  - b. Review and approve Preliminary Official Statement and Official Notice of Sale;
  - c. Authorize the District's financial advisor to advertise for the sale of the Road Bonds;
  - d. Approve designation of Paying Agent/Registrar; and
  - e. Authorize bookkeeper to issue payment for Attorney General's fees;

5. Consider approval of Resolution to Comply with Securities and Exchange Commission Rule 15c2-12 and General Certificates in connection therewith: (i) Harris-Waller Counties Municipal Utility District No. 4 \$15,770,000 Contract Revenue Bonds, Series 2024, and (ii) Harris-Waller Counties Municipal Utility District No. 4 \$16,395,000 Contract Revenue Road Bonds, Series 2024;
6. Tax Assessor-Collector Report;
7. Receive the Financial Advisor's recommendation concerning the District's proposed 2024 tax rate, determine intended tax rate, and authorize:
  - a. the required notice that the Board will consider adoption of a tax rate; and
  - b. the means of providing such notice;
