The items of business to be considered and transacted at said meeting are as follows:

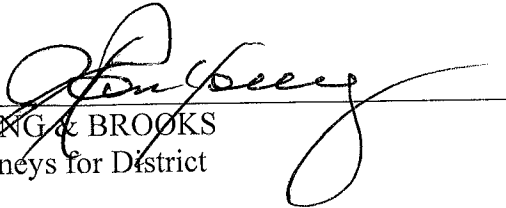
1. Approve minutes of prior meetings.

4. Conduct public hearing on proposed 2025 tax rate.
5. Adopt order establishing ad valorem tax rate for 2025 and amend district information form, if necessary.
6. Consider rate order amendment.
7. Consider amendment to operator contract.
8. Convene Executive Session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Sec. 551.071 to consider legal matters.
9. Reconvene public session and take action on any matters discussed during the executive session.

* All public must observe a three-minute time limit.

The District has implemented procedures to allow members of the public to participate and address the Board of Directors during meetings held via videoconference. All participants have the option of joining the meeting by videoconference using a computer or other internet capable device. If you are trying to join the videoconference via mobile device or tablet, you may need to download the Microsoft Teams mobile application. All public participants will automatically be muted. During the Public Comment portion of the meeting, participants may unmute their line to make a comment. Audio and video of the meeting will be recorded.
