Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a regular public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District.

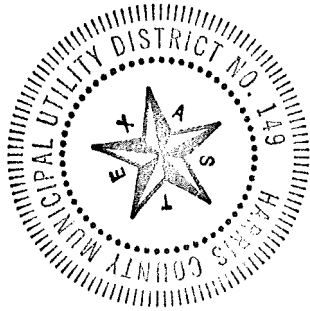
The meeting will be held on **Monday, November 17, 2025, at 1:30 p.m.**

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action necessary or appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public Comments;
2. Review and approve the minutes of the October 20, 2025, Board meeting;
3. Trash and recycling collection report from GFL Environmental;
4. Tax Assessor-Collector report, including authorizing payment of invoices presented and approve moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
5. Report and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney, including:
 - a) Appeals of termination of water service for delinquent tax accounts; and the taking of any action in connection therewith, including authorizing water termination, foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
6. Bookkeeper's Report, including payment of invoices presented;
7. Authorize preparation and filing of initial Local Government Bond, Tax, and Project report pursuant to Chapter 403, Texas Government Code, as amended by House Bill 103;
8. Operations and Maintenance report, including:
 - a) Authorize repairs and maintenance of District facilities, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, as applicable;
 - b) Appeals of District charges;
 - c) Referral of accounts for collection and approve write-off of uncollectible accounts; and
 - d) Communications with customers, including mass messaging;
9. Approval of Sludge Management Agreement with Inframark and K-3/BMI;
10. Engineering report, including:
 - a) Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for the construction of facilities within the District;
 - b) Authorize the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, and authorize acceptance of

- c) TEC Form 1295, as applicable, and approval of any related stormwater permits;
Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any change orders, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, as applicable, including:
 - 1. Rehabilitation of digesters at Wastewater Treatment Plant; and
 - 2. Water Plant Replacement Project;
 - d) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, as applicable; and
 - e) Capital Improvement Plan;
- 11. Report from Champions Hydro-Lawn, Inc., including maintenance of detention facilities for the 4.66 acres Barker Cypress/FM 529, L.P. tract, the sites of the Wastewater Treatment Plant, Water Plant, and Off-Site Lift Station, and the Harris County Flood Control District channel;
 - 12. Discussion regarding surface water issues relative to the West Harris County Regional Water Authority;
 - 13. Designating or confirming a representative to vote in the Association of Water Board Directors bylaws amendments and elections;
 - 14. Matters related to the Directors Election to be called for May 2, 2026, including authorization to post Notice Regarding Candidate Filing Period;
 - 15. Attorney's Report, including:
 - a) Status of Builders Damages demand letters;
 - b) Authorize attorney to file Eminent Domain Report with the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts prior to February 1, 2026, pursuant to Section 2206.154, Texas Government Code; and
 - c) Status of litigation by Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 257 against Si Environmental, LLC and the District regarding reported usage amounts related to expenses to operate and maintain joint Water Plant and joint Wastewater Treatment Plant (Cause No. 2022-79830; 61st District Court, Harris County, Texas);
 - 16. Closed Session pursuant to Texas Open Meetings Act, including but not limited to consultation with attorney pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code regarding pending or threatened litigation and/or matters protected by attorney-client privilege;
 - 17. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any action resulting from matters discussed in Closed Session; and
 - 18. Consideration of matters for possible placement on future agendas.
