 - (b) reconstitute the Board of Directors, pursuant to Section 49.054(b), Texas Water Code, and authorize filing of District Registration Form with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality;
 - (c) discuss training requirements of appointed director;
- 3. Approval of the minutes of the meetings of 3 November 2025;
- 4. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including:
 - (a) approve payments from the District's tax account:
 - (b) review status of actions for the collection of taxes, penalties, and interest due to the District and take any necessary action;

 - (d) Mission Bend Integrated Water System matters;

- (e) Chelford City Regional Wastewater Treatment Facility matters;
- (f) consider Professional Services Agreement between Vogler & Spencer Engineering, Inc. and the District;
- 7. Old business, including:
 - (a) discuss items considered by the Mission Bend Greenbelt Association;
 - (b) status of the Phase II Small MS4 General Permit and Storm Water Management Program and authorize any actions deemed necessary;
- 8. New business, including:
 - (a) appoint director as voting member representative to vote on proposed Association of Water Board Directors Bylaws, if necessary;
 - (b) discuss Chelford City Regional Wastewater Treatment Facility contract(s);
 - (c) discuss director responsibilities;
- 9. Operator's Report, including:
 - (a) review of maintenance list for the District;
 - (b) report on operations of the District's facilities, including authorization for any necessary maintenance or repairs;
 - (c) authorize termination of services for nonpayment of invoices from the District and consider requests for extensions and adjustments;
 - (d) discuss and adopt Amended Rate Order, if necessary;
- 10. Attorney's Report, including status of request for Water Line and Meter Easement (West Harris County Regional Water Authority); and
- 11. Schedule future meetings as required (next meeting date is 5 January 2025).
