Minutes of the Meeting of Board of Directors April 8, 2024

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 569 (the "District") met in regular session, open to the public, on April 8, 2024, in accordance with the duly posted Notice of Public Meeting, and the roll was called of the duly constituted members of the Board, as follows:

Jason Schultz, President Nicholas Luton, Vice President Blakely Norris, Secretary David Jezierski, Assistant Secretary Julia Pecina, Assistant Secretary

all of whom were present, thus constituting a quorum.

Also present were: Blair Bozoarth of Quiddity Engineering, LLC ("Quiddity"); Jennifer Abad of Municipal Accounts & Consulting, L.P. ("MA&C"); Dana Hollingsworth of Municipal District Services, LLC ("MDS"); Patty Rodriguez of BLICO, Inc., dba Bob Leared Interests ("BLICO"); Shamar O'Bryant on behalf of Astro Sunterra, L.P. ("Astro Sunterra"); and Christina Cole and Kris Eddlemon of Schwartz, Page & Harding, L.L.P. ("SPH").

The President called the meeting to order and declared it open for such business as might regularly come before the Board.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no comments from members of the public.

MINUTES

The Board considered the minutes of its meeting held on March 11, 2024. After discussion regarding the minutes previously forwarded for review, it was moved by Director Norris, seconded by Director Luton and unanimously carried, that said minutes be approved, as written.

TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR'S REPORT

Ms. Rodriguez presented to and reviewed with the Board a written Tax Assessor-Collector Report ("TAC Report"), for the period ended March 31, 2024, including the disbursements presented therein for payment from the District's tax account, a copy of which TAC Report is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. After discussion, on motion made by Director Norris, seconded by Director Luton and unanimously carried, the Board approved the TAC Report and authorized the

payments listed therein.

RESOLUTION REQUESTING APPRAISAL OF PROPERTY

The Board considered the approval and execution of a Resolution Requesting Appraisal of Property as of May 1, 2024. After discussion on the matter, Director Norris moved that the Board adopt a Resolution Authorizing Request for Appraisal of Property as of May 1, 2024, attached hereto as **Exhibit B**, and that the President be authorized to execute same on behalf of the Board and District. Director Luton seconded said motion, which unanimously carried.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL PENALTY ON DELINQUENT REAL PROPERTY TAXES

The Board considered the adoption of a Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Real Property Taxes. Ms. Cole advised that the Board is authorized, pursuant to Section 33.07 of the Texas Tax Code, as amended, to impose, under certain conditions on July 1, an additional penalty not to exceed twenty percent (20%) of the total taxes, penalty and interest due the District on taxes that remain delinquent as of July 1 of the year in which they became delinquent. She noted that the additional penalty to be imposed by this Resolution will not apply to delinquent personal property taxes which have incurred an additional penalty pursuant to that certain Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Personal Property Taxes, which was passed and approved by the District on January 8, 2024. After further discussion, it was moved by Director Norris, seconded by Director Luton, and unanimously carried, that the Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Real Property Taxes, attached hereto as **Exhibit C**, be adopted by the District, and that the District's delinquent tax collections attorneys be authorized to proceed with the collection of the District's 2023 delinquent real property tax accounts on July 1, 2024, subject to proper notice having been given as provided in said Resolution, including the filing of lawsuits as necessary.

OPERATOR'S REPORT

Ms. Hollingsworth presented to and reviewed with the Board the Operations Report dated April 8, 2024, a copy of which is attached is attached hereto as **Exhibit D**. She noted that no Board action was required in connection with the Operations Report at this time.

IDENTITY THEFT PREVENTION PROGRAM

The Board then considered review of the District's Identity Theft Prevention Program (the "Program"). In connection therewith, Ms. Hollingsworth presented MDS' annual report and advised the Board regarding the District's experience with identity theft during the prior year, current identity theft methods, the types of accounts maintained by the District and the District's business arrangements with other entities. She recommended that no changes be made to the District's Program. After discussion on the matter, the Board concurred that no changes were necessary to the District's Program at this time.

DROUGHT CONTINGENCY PLAN

Ms. Cole next discussed with the Board the requirements of Title 30, Section 288.30 of the Texas Administrative Code for retail public water suppliers such as the District to review and, if appropriate, revise their Drought Contingency Plan ("DCP") no later than May 1, 2024, and every five years thereafter. She further advised that no changes are being recommended to the District's DCP at this time. After discussion, Director Norris moved that the District adopt the Resolution Regarding Review of Drought Contingency Plan, attached hereto as **Exhibit E**. Director Luton seconded such motion, which passed unanimously.

CONSUMER CONFIDENCE REPORT

The Board considered authorizing MDS to prepare a draft Consumer Confidence Report ("CCR") for review by the Board. Ms. Cole advised that pursuant to CCR requirements promulgated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ"), the District is required to provide a report containing various information regarding the District's water supply to all customers of the District by July 1, 2024. After discussion on the matter, it was moved by Director Norris seconded by Director Luton and unanimously carried, that MDS be authorized to prepare a draft CCR and SPH be authorized to review same for compliance with the TCEQ's regulatory requirements and its 2024 template.

ENGINEERING REPORT

Mr. Bozoarth presented to and reviewed with the Board an Engineering Report dated April 8, 2024, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit F, relative to the status of various engineering and construction projects within the District. Upon review, Director Norris moved that the Board approve (i) Pay Estimate No. 2 in the amount of \$919,280.40 from Durwood Greene Construction Co. for construction of paving facilities serving Sunterra Section 45, (ii) Pay Estimate No. 3 in the amount of \$42,219.92 from A&M Contractors, Inc. for construction of paving facilities serving Sunterra Section 51, (c) Pay Estimate No. 1 in the amount of \$973,569.92 from Gonzalez Construction Enterprises, Inc. for construction of water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities serving Sunterra Section 57, (d) Pay Estimate No. 1 in the amount of \$59,773.50 from Daco Paving, Inc. for construction of paving facilities serving Sunterra Section 57, (e) Pay Estimate No. 2 in the amount of \$277,199.36 from Principal Services, Ltd. for construction of water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities serving Sunterra Section 58, (f) Pay Estimate No. 1 in the amount of \$68,028.57 from Daco Paving, Inc. for construction of paving facilities serving Sunterra Section 58, and (g) Pay Estimate No. 1 in the amount of \$39,106.80 from De Crosta Construction, LLC for construction of paving facilities serving Sunterra Section 59. Director Luton seconded the motion, which unanimously carried.

SILT SOLUTIONS, INC.

The Board next considered a report from Silt Solutions, Inc. ("SSI") in connection with storm water pollutions and prevention services. Ms. Cole advised that SSI provided a report for the period March 11, 2024 – April 2, 2024, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit G**. No action was taken by the Board at this time.

LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT REPORT(S)

The Board reviewed a landscape architect report provided by KGA DeForest Design, LLC, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit H**, and noted that no action was required on behalf of the Board at this time.

BOOKKEEPER'S REPORT AND QUARTERLY INVESTMENT REPORT

Ms. Abad presented to and reviewed with the Board the Bookkeeper's Report, dated April 8, 2024, attached hereto as **Exhibit I**, including the disbursements presented for payment, as prepared by MA&C. Ms. Abad also presented to and reviewed with the Board a Quarterly Investment Inventory Report for the investment period ended February 29, 2024, a copy of which report is included in the Bookkeeper's Report. After discussion, it was moved by Director Norris that (i) the Bookkeeper's Report be approved, and that the disbursements identified in the Bookkeeper's Report be authorized for payment, and (ii) the Quarterly Investment Report for the investment period ended February 29, 2024, be approved as presented, and the Investment Officers of the District be authorized to execute same on behalf of the Board and the District. Director Luton seconded said motion, which unanimously carried.

UNCLAIMED PROPERTY REPORT

The Board considered approval of an Unclaimed Property Report as of March 1, 2024, and the filing of same with the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts (the "Comptroller") prior to July 1, 2024. In connection therewith, Ms. Abad noted that the District has no unclaimed operating funds. Ms. Rodriguez then reported that the District has no unclaimed tax funds for the applicable reporting period, and noted that BLICO will submit its Unclaimed Property Report reflecting same. After discussion, Director Norris moved that MA&C and BLICO be authorized to file said Reports with the Comptroller prior to July 1, 2024. Director Luton seconded said motion, which unanimously carried.

DEVELOPER'S REPORT

Mr. O'Bryant discussed the status of development within the District.

SECURITY PATROL REPORT

Ms. Cole presented to and reviewed with the Board the Security Patrol Report prepared by On-Site Services, LLC for the month of March 2024, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit J**.

ATTORNEY'S REPORT

The Board next considered the Attorney's Report. In connection therewith, Ms. Cole advised the Board that the District is in receipt of an open records request from Real Cost Analytics requesting copies of certain documents related to the construction of facilities to serve Sunterra Sections 59, 60, 61, and 62. She further advised that SPH will provide the requested documents to

Real Cost Analytics on behalf of the District. It was noted that no action was required of the Board at this time in connection with said request.

FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

The Board considered items for placement on future agendas. No items were requested to be added to future agendas other than those items discussed hereinabove.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, on motion made by Director Norris, seconded by Director Luton, and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned.

RESOLUTION REQUESTING APPRAISAL OF PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 569 (the "District") is considering the issuance of bonds of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District now requires an estimate of appraised value for properties located within the boundaries of the District; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 25, Section 25.18 of the Texas Tax Code ("Code"), as amended, provides that a taxing unit by resolution adopted by its governing body may require the appraisal office to appraise all property within the unit as of a date specified in the resolution. Now, Therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 569, THAT:

Section 1: The District hereby requests that the Harris Central Appraisal District conduct an appraisal of property located within the boundaries of the District as of May 1, 2024.

Section 2: The District be provided with five (5) copies of such estimate of appraised value, certified by the chief appraiser of said appraisal district.

Section 3: The District be provided with such certificate of assessed value on or before thirty (30) days from the date of receipt hereof in accordance with Section 25.18(c) of the Code.

Section 4: The District be charged with all costs incurred by said appraisal district in conducting the appraisal herein requested.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL PENALTY ON DELINOUENT REAL PROPERTY TAXES

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 569 (the "District") is desirous of defraying the costs of collection of delinquent taxes; and

WHEREAS, the District has contracted with an attorney for collection of delinquent taxes as set forth in Section 6.30 of V.T.C.A. Tax Code, as amended ("Tax Code"); and

WHEREAS, Section 33.07 of the Tax Code, as amended, provides that, if the District has contracted with an attorney under Section 6.30 of the Tax Code, as amended, for collection of the District's delinquent taxes, the District may impose an additional penalty not to exceed the amount of the compensation specified in the contract with the attorney to be paid in connection with the collection of the delinquent taxes on taxes that become delinquent on or after February 1 of a year but not later than May 1 of that year and that remain delinquent on July 1 of the year in which they become delinquent; and

WHEREAS, Section 33.08 of the Tax Code, as amended, provides that if the District imposes the additional penalty for collection costs under Section 33.07 of the Tax Code, as amended, and has contracted with an attorney under Section 6.30 of the Tax Code, as amended, for collection of the District's delinquent taxes, the District may impose an additional penalty not to exceed the amount of the compensation specified in the contract with the attorney to be paid in connection with the collection of the delinquent taxes on taxes that become delinquent on or after June 1 of a year; and

WHEREAS, said Section 6.30 provides that said compensation shall not exceed twenty percent (20%) of the amount of delinquent tax, penalty and interest collected. Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 569, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. The District has entered into a contract with an attorney pursuant to Section 6.30 of the Texas Tax Code, as amended, for the collection of delinquent taxes, penalty and interest.

Section 2. District taxes that become delinquent on or after February 1 of a year but not later than May 1 of that year and that remain delinquent on July 1 of the year in which such taxes become delinquent shall incur an additional penalty of twenty percent (20%) on the amount of such taxes, penalty and interest to defray the costs of collection of said delinquent taxes, in accordance with Section 33.07 of the Tax Code, as amended.

Section 3. District taxes that become delinquent on or after June 1 of a year shall incur an additional penalty of twenty percent (20%) of the amount of such taxes, penalty and interest on the first day of the first month that begins at least twenty-one (21) days after the date the notice of delinquency and penalty are sent, in accordance with Section 33.08 of the Tax Code, as amended.

<u>Section 4</u>. The District's tax collector shall deliver a notice of delinquency and of the penalty imposed pursuant to Section 2 above to the property owner at least thirty (30) and not more than sixty (60) days before July 1.

<u>Section 5</u>. The District's tax collector shall deliver a notice of delinquency and of the penalty imposed pursuant to Section 3 above to the property owner.

<u>Section 6</u>. Notwithstanding any provision in this Resolution to the contrary, the additional penalty imposed hereunder shall not apply to delinquent personal property taxes which have incurred an additional penalty pursuant to that certain Resolution Authorizing An Additional Penalty on Delinquent Personal Property Taxes passed and approved by the District on the 8th day of January, 2024.

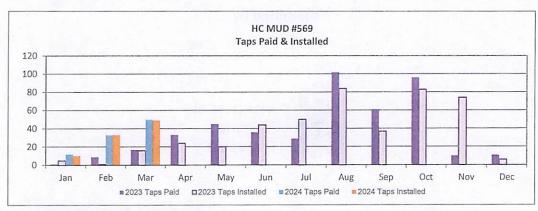

January 1 to December 31, 2023

This report is to provide the status of Municipal District Services' implementation of the District's Identity Theft Prevention Program.

Status

Current Municipal District Services employees involved in handling customer information completed the annual training and signed acknowledgement forms by April 30, 2024. The Identity Theft Prevention Program on file with Municipal District Services for the District is dated May 2022. We have no suggested changes for the program as written.

Effectiveness of Policies and Procedures

Municipal District Services has implemented appropriate policies and procedures to comply with the District Identity Theft Prevention Program. During 2023 MDS began additional safeguards:

- Relocating data systems to a hardened facility outside the hurricane strike zone.
- Added improved redundant systems for power, fiber optic connectivity and server failover capacity.
- Enhanced the MDS threat detection and response platform that employs AI detection resources.
- Upgraded Microsoft infrastructure to the latest platform(s).

Service Provider Arrangements

Municipal District Services requires Service Providers to submit documentation annually that they are in compliance with the District's Red Flag rules.

Significant Incidents Involving Identity Theft and Management Response

Account Balance By Month | April 2023 - March 2024

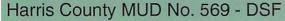

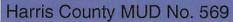

Investment Profile as of 04/08/2024



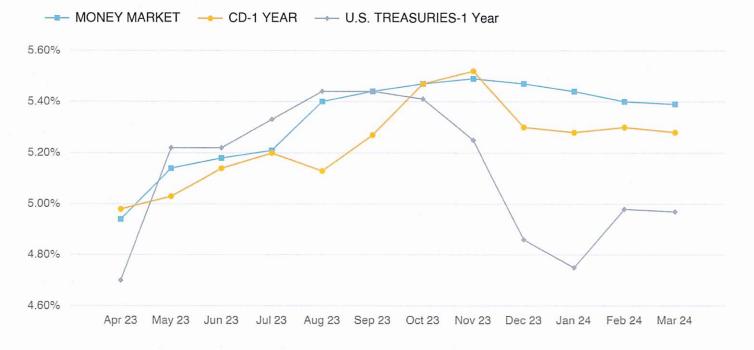

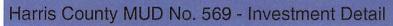
