Minutes of the Meeting of Board of Directors June 10, 2024

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Waller County Municipal Utility District No. 35 (the "District") met in regular session, open to the public, on June 10, 2024, in accordance with the duly posted Notice of Public Meeting, and the roll was called of the duly constituted members of the Board, as follows:

Victoria A. Battistini, President Ryan C. Ward, Vice President Jaclyn Day, Secretary Daniel C. Feiler, Assistant Secretary Tiffani S. Walker, Assistant Secretary

all of whom were present with the exception of Directors Ward and Walker, thus constituting a quorum. Directors Ward and Walker entered later in the meeting, as noted herein.

Also present were: Blair Bozoarth of Quiddity Engineering, LLC ("Quiddity"); Jennifer Abad of Municipal Accounts & Consulting, L.P. ("MA&C"); Dana Hollingsworth of Municipal District Services, LLC ("MDS"); Stephen Eustis of Robert W. Baird & Co., Inc. ("Baird"); Patty Rodriguez of BLICO, Inc., dba Bob Leared Interests ("BLICO"); Shamar O'Bryant on behalf of Astro Sunterra, L.P. ("Astro Sunterra"); David Daughtry of Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc. ("KH"); and Christina Cole and Kate Gribble of Schwartz, Page & Harding, L.L.P. ("SPH").

The President called the meeting to order and declared it open for such business as might regularly come before the Board.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no comments from members of the public.

MINUTES

The Board considered the minutes of its meeting held on May 13, 2024. After discussion regarding the minutes previously forwarded for review, it was moved by Director Battistini, seconded by Director Day, and unanimously carried, that said minutes be approved, as written.

TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR REPORT

Ms. Rodriguez presented to and reviewed with the Board a written Tax Assessor-Collector Report ("TAC Report") for the period ended May 31, 2024, including the disbursements presented therein for payment from the District's tax account, a copy of which TAC Report is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. After discussion, on motion made by Director Feiler, seconded by Director Battistini

and unanimously carried, the Board approved the TAC Report and authorized the payments listed therein.

Director Ward entered the meeting at this time.

OPERATOR'S REPORT

Ms. Hollingsworth presented to and reviewed with the Board the Operations Report dated June 10, 2024, a copy of which is attached is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**. She noted that no Board action was required in connection with the Operations Report at this time.

ENGINEERING REPORT

Mr. Bozoarth next presented to and reviewed with the Board an Engineering Report dated June 7, 2024, a copy of which report is attached hereto as **Exhibit C**, relative to the status of various engineering and construction projects within the District. Upon review, Director Feiler moved that the Engineering Report and all actions noted therein be approved as recommended by Quiddity. Director Battistini seconded the motion, which unanimously carried.

Director Walker entered the meeting during the Engineering Report.

2024 ROAD BONDS

The Board deferred approval of a Summary of Costs in connection with the District's 2024 Road Bonds. The Board then considered engagement of an auditor to prepare an audit of payments to the developer out of the 2024 Road Bonds. In that regard, Ms. Cole presented to and reviewed with the Board an engagement letter provided by Forvis Mazars, LLP ("Forvis"), a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit D**. Following discussion, Director Ward moved that the Board (i) approve the engagement letter, (ii) authorize the President to execute same on behalf of the Board and the District, and (iii) authorize SPH to accept and acknowledge the associated Texas Ethics Commission 1295 Form provided by Forvis. Director Battistini seconded the motion, which unanimously carried.

SILT SOLUTIONS, INC.

The Board deferred a report from Silt Solutions, Inc. in connection with storm water pollutions and prevention services until the next meeting.

LANDSCAPE ARCHITECURE REPORT(S)

Mr. Daughtry next presented to and reviewed with the Board a monthly report prepared by KH regarding the status of landscape architecture design services within the District, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit E**. Following discussion, Director Battistini moved to approve Pay Estimate No. 9 and Final in connection with hardscape, landscape, and irrigation improvements to serve Sunterra Sections 49-50. Director Ward seconded the motion, which unanimously carried.

BOOKKEEPER'S REPORT

Ms. Abad presented to and reviewed with the Board the Bookkeeper's Report, dated June 10, 2024, attached hereto as **Exhibit F**, including the disbursements presented for payment, as prepared by MA&C. After discussion, it was moved by Director Ward that the Bookkeeper's Report be approved, and that the disbursements identified in the Bookkeeper's Report be authorized for payment. Director Battistini seconded said motion, which unanimously carried.

DEVELOPER'S REPORT

Mr. O'Bryant discussed the status of development within the District.

SECURITY PATROL REPORT

Ms. Cole presented to and reviewed with the Board the Security Patrol Report prepared by On-Site Services, LLC for the month of May 2024, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit G**.

<u>AUTHORIZATION FOR COMPLETION, EXECUTION AND FILING OF VOTING SYSTEM ANNUAL FILING FORM</u>

The Board next considered authorizing the completion and execution of the Voting System Annual Filing Form and filing of same with the Secretary of State's office. Ms. Cole advised the Board that, under the Texas Election Code, the District is required to complete and file said form provided by the Secretary of State regarding information related to District elections. After discussion, Director Ward moved to approve the execution and filing of said Voting System Annual Filing Form relative to District elections. Director Battistini seconded the motion, which unanimously carried.

ATTORNEY'S REPORT

The Board next considered the Attorney's Report. In connection therewith, Ms. Cole advised the Board that the District is in receipt of an open records request from Real Cost Analytics requesting copies of certain documents related to the construction of facilities to serve Sunterra Sections 67, 68, 72, 73, and 74. She further advised that SPH will provide the requested documents to Real Cost Analytics on behalf of the District. It was noted that no action was required of the Board at this time in connection with said request.

FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

The Board considered items for placement on future agendas. No items were requested to be added to future agendas other than those items discussed hereinabove.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, on motion made by Director Feiler, seconded by Director Battistini, and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned.

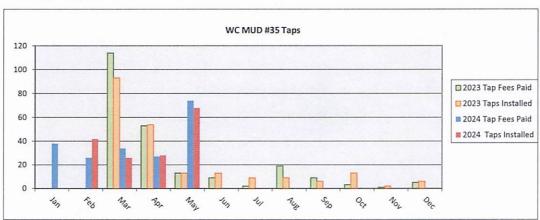

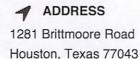

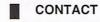

General Operating Fund Tax Revenues are to be used for expenses related to the Operations of the District. Surplus tax funds can be used freely for Operations, however use of these funds towards non-operational expenses may require TCEQ authorization.



Debt Service Tax Revenues are restricted and can only be used to pay down the Principal and Interest of the District Bonds, or to pay the Districts share of other debt through Debt Contract Taxes. Districts are required to have enough funds to cover yearly payments plus a quarter of next year's requirements. As the outstanding debt obligation decreases, so can the Debt Service tax rate needed to generate those collections.

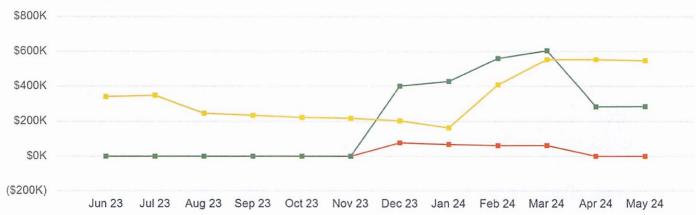

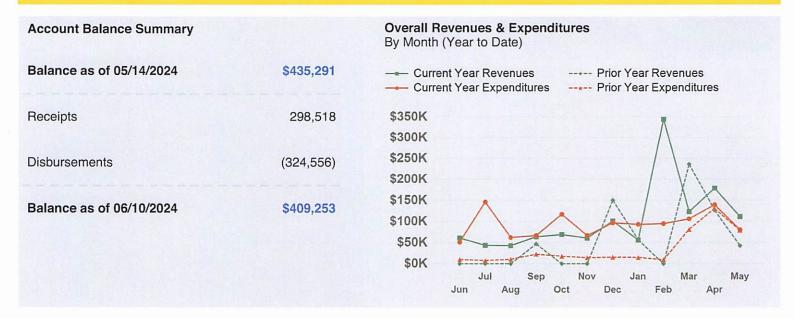
Account Balance By Month | June 2023 - May 2024

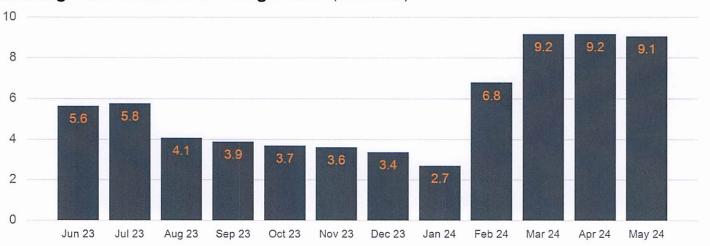

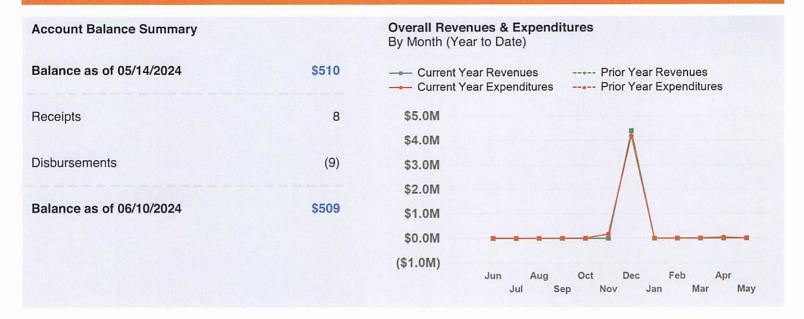

Account Balance By Month I June 2023 - May 2024

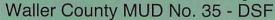

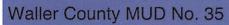

Investment Profile as of 06/10/2024



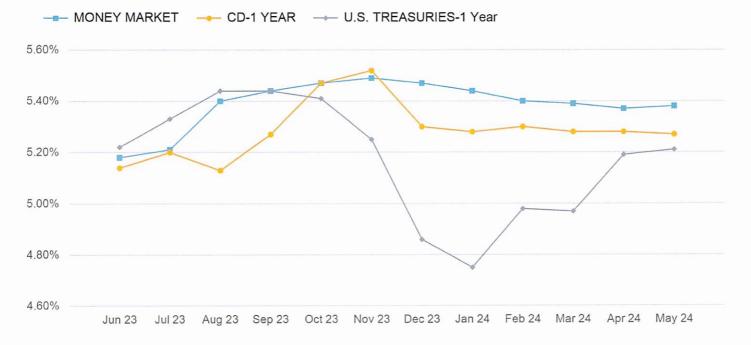

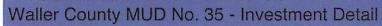
