

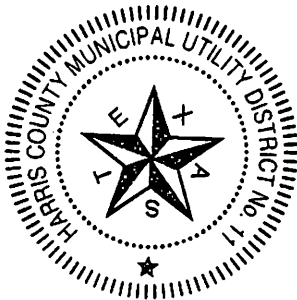


Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 11 will hold a special meeting, open to the public, on **WEDNESDAY, 17 DECEMBER 2025, at 5:00 P.M.** at the offices of Coats Rose, P.C., **9 Greenway Plaza, Suite 1000, Houston, Texas 77046**, outside the boundaries of the District. The Board will consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Comments and questions from District residents (five-minute limit for each speaker);
2. Approval of the minutes of the meetings of 19 November 2025 and 3 December 2025;
3. Operator's Report, including:
 - (a) report on operations of the District's facilities;
 - (b) status of various repairs or replacement of equipment at District facilities;
 - (c) review actual termination list;
 - (d) correspondence from customers of the District, including requests for adjustments;
4. Engineer's Report, including:
 - (a) discuss matters relating to Water Supply and Groundwater Reduction Plan Wholesale Agreement (City of Houston);
 - (b) status of requests for service;
 - (c) status of waterline replacement under ditch serving Section 3;
 - (d) status of Rate Study;
 - (e) update on other matters as needed;
5. Bookkeeper's Report, including:
 - (a) authorize payment of the District's bills;
 - (b) review and approve Investment Report;
6. Old business;

7. New business, including confirm continued engagement of auditor to prepare the Annual Financial Report for the District for the fiscal year ending 31 December 2025;
8. Attorney's Report, including;
 - (a) approve Sales Agreement between the District and Kenneth Vasina and Marvin Zahradnik;
 - (b) approve deed conveying 13138 Daywood Drive to Kenneth Vasina and Marvin Zahradnik;
 - (c) approve Utility Commitment, Annexation, Service, Development and Financing Agreement between the District and Urban Logistics Realty;
 - (d) status of bond, tax, and project database (HB 103) reporting to the Texas Comptroller;
