TO: THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 11 OF HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS, AND TO ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 11 will hold a regular meeting, open to the public, on **WEDNESDAY, 7 JANUARY 2026, at 5:00 P.M.** at the offices of Coats Rose, P.C., **9 Greenway Plaza, Suite 1000, Houston, Texas**, outside the boundaries of the District. The Board will consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Comments and questions from District residents (five-minute limit for each speaker);
2. Approval of the minutes of the meetings of 19 November 2025 and 3 December 2025;
3. Operator's Report, including:
 - (a) report on operations of the District's facilities;
 - (b) status of various repairs or replacement of equipment at District facilities;
 - (c) review actual termination list;
 - (d) correspondence from customers of the District, including requests for adjustments;
4. Report on Storm Water Detention Facilities (as needed);
5. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including:
 - (a) authorize payments from the District's tax account;
 - (b) status of collection of taxes, penalties, and interest due to the District for real and personal property accounts and consider termination of services for such accounts;
6. Engineer's Report (updates as needed);
7. Report regarding security matters in the District (Harris County Sheriff's Office);
8. Old business;

9. New business;
10. Attorney's Report, including:
 - (a) approve Sales Agreement between the District and Kenneth Vasina and Marvin Zahradnik;
 - (b) approve deed conveying 13138 Daywood Drive to Kenneth Vasina and Marvin Zahradnik;
 - (c) approve Utility Commitment, Annexation, Service, Development and Financing Agreement between the District and Urban Logistics Realty;
11. Convene in executive session pursuant to Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, to discuss matters only relating to pending or contemplated litigation, personnel matters, real estate transactions, or security, if necessary;
12. Action related to matters discussed during executive session; and
13. Schedule future meetings as required (next meeting date is **28 January 2026**).

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Notice: After at least 50 qualified electors are residing in a district, on written request of at least five of those electors, the board shall designate a meeting place and hold meetings within the district if it determines that the meeting place used by the district deprives the residents of a reasonable opportunity to attend district meetings. On the failure to designate the location of the meeting place within the district, five electors may petition the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to designate a location. If it determines that the meeting place used by the district deprives the residents of a reasonable opportunity to attend district meetings, the TCEQ may designate a meeting place inside or outside the district which is reasonably available to the public and require that the meetings be held at such place. After the next election, the board may designate different meeting places, including one located outside the boundaries of the district.
