PUBLIC COMMENT

Director Coleman offered any members of the public attending the meeting the opportunity to make public comment. There being no public comments, Director Coleman moved to the next agenda item.

MINUTES

The Board considered approving the special meeting minutes of December 8, 2025. Following review and discussion, Director Cropper moved to approve the special meeting minutes of December 8, 2025, as presented. Director Crafton seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote.

SECURITY REPORT

Deputy Endsley presented and reviewed the security report from the Harris County Sheriff's Office ("HCSO"), a copy of which is attached.

PARK MATTERS

Director Cronin updated the Board regarding District park matters.

Director Crafton updated the Board regarding the Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 364 trail modifications project. Discussion ensued regarding potential future trail projects.

#### RECYCLING SERVICES

The Board reviewed a report on recycling matters within the District, a copy of which is attached.

Director Cronin reported on recycling items left in the street.

#### ENGINEERING AND OPERATING MATTERS

Ms. Carner updated the Board regarding the easement documents for the North Harris County Regional Water Authority ("NHCRWA") surface water projects, noting the documents have been approved.

Director Coleman updated the Board regarding the drainage improvements project on Twisting Ivy Lane in the Park at Arbordale.

#### WATER CONSERVATION AND DRAINAGE MATTERS

The Board discussed the Detention Basin Project environmental study, noting the study is underway to determine whether the pilot channel will require a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers jurisdictional determination.

Director Crafton updated the Board regarding the flood mitigation evaluation being prepared by the San Jacinto Regional Flood Planning Group, noting that two District areas have been approved for inclusion in the study.

#### COMMUNITY EVENTS

Director Cropper discussed holding a community event on World Water Day in April, 2026, related to the District's water conservation efforts.

#### COMMUNICATION MATTERS


Director Moore updated the Board regarding website postings.
