CONSENT AGENDA: The following items are considered routine by the Board and will be enacted by one motion. No separate discussion will occur on these items unless a Board member so requests, in which event, the item will be removed and placed on the Regular Agenda.


1. Approve minutes.
2. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
3. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
4. Operator's report of District water, sanitary sewer, and stormwater facilities, including billings, repairs and maintenance.



5. Public comment.*
6. San Jacinto Regional Flood Planning Group flood mitigation evaluation for Coles Crossing detention pond, and take appropriate action.
7. Coles Crossing Stormwater Detention and Water Quality Improvement Project, including:
 - a. update on federal grant application, associated costs, timeline for implementation, and related matters; and
 - b. update on design.
8. Additional bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. discuss Association of Water Board Directors winter conference, approve reimbursement of eligible expenses, and authorize attendance at summer conference.
9. Additional operating matters, including:
 - a. authorize operator to send uncollectable accounts to collection agency;
 - b. customer contact log;
 - c. authorize water rate study; and
 - d. amend Rate Order.
10. Hearing on termination of water service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.

 - a. review delinquent tax roll and write off accounts, as appropriate;
 - b. adopt Resolution Concerning Exemptions from Taxation; and
 - c. adopt Resolution Regarding Development Status for 2026 Tax Year.

13. Recreational and landscape matters, including:
 - a. proposal for debris removal;
 - b. proposal for overseeding and fertilization;
 - c. review bids and award contracts;
 - d. approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance, as appropriate, including Coles Crossing Recreational Trail Signage project;
 - e. trail, detention and common area maintenance, signage, water fountains, and interactive fountain;
 - f. fencing repairs and replacement; and
 - g. tree installation, maintenance, and removal.
14. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. utility availability requests;
 - b. design, plan approval, advertisement for bids, contract award, approval of pay estimates and change orders, materials and field testing, permitting, storm water quality management plans, storm water pollution prevention plans, and other necessary actions relating to facilities, including:
 - i. smart meters;
 - ii. erosion repair of backslope interceptor; and
 - iii. joint water plant coatings;
 - c. feasibility study regarding potential water plant control system improvements;
 - d. deeds, easements, and encroachments, including update on North Harris County Regional Water Authority distribution and surface water lines and take appropriate action;
 - e. update on conveyance of lift station no. 2 site to the District and take appropriate action;
 - f. update on potential conveyance of park tracts;
 - g. annual review of Capital Improvement Plan;
 - h. update on request to Harris County for funding assistance for drainage/detention projects;
 - i. request from homeowners association for installation of bollards or other access barriers on District drainage facilities; and
 - j. other engineering matters.

Engaging in verbal attacks or comments intended to insult, abuse, malign, or slander any individual shall be cause for termination of time privileges.

Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 365 reserves the right to adjourn into executive session at any time during the course of this meeting to discuss any of the matters listed above, as authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code §§ 551.071 (Consultation with Attorney), 551.072 (Deliberations about Real Property), 551.073 (Deliberations about Gifts and Donations), 551.074 (Personnel Matters), 551.076 (Deliberation about Security Devices), and any other provision under Texas law that permits a governmental body to discuss a matter in a closed executive session.
